## Conference Notes

- Four SEC teams are ranked in the Associated Press Top 25: Tennessee (3rd), Auburn (12th), Kentucky (13th) and Mississippi State (17th). Florida is among the teams receiving votes.

- Eight SEC schools rank in the Top 50 of the NCAA's NET rankings (as of Dec. 31) – Tennessee (6th), Kentucky (11th), Mississippi State (19th), Auburn (22nd), LSU (27th), Florida (33rd), Ole Miss (42nd) and Vanderbilt (44th).

- Ten SEC schools have played schedules that rank among the Top 150 SOS in the NCAA's NET (as of Dec. 31).

- Thirteen SEC teams rank among the top 100 NCAA leaders in blocked shots per game with six schools occupying the top 13 spots (as of Dec. 31). Georgia leads the SEC and ranks fourth nationally (6.3 bpg), Auburn is fifth (6.2), Arkansas and Tennessee are tied for seventh (6.2), Kentucky 11th (5.8) and Texas A&M 13th (5.6).

- Three SEC basketball players were named candidates for the 2018-19 Senior CLASS Award – Kentucky's Reid Travis, Mississippi State's Aric Holman and South Carolina's Chris Silva.

- The SEC Graduate Patch is being displayed on the uniforms of 10 SEC men's basketball student-athletes this year.

- The SEC schedule begins with five games on Saturday, Jan. 5, and runs through Saturday, March 9.

- The Southeastern Conference Tournament returns to Bridgestone Arena in Nashville for the eighth time in 2019. The SEC recently extended its agreement with the Nashville Sports Council that could make Music City the home of the SEC Tournament through 2035.

## Team/Individual Notes

- SEC Player of the Week – Georgia forward Nicolas Claxton, a 6-foot-11, 220-pound sophomore from Greenville, S.C., posted game-high efforts of 20 points, 11 rebounds and three blocks to lead Georgia to a 91-72 victory over UMass. Claxton connected on 8-of-13 shots from the floor and 3-of-3 attempts at the line. He notched his eighth double-digit scoring performance and his second 20-point outing of the season. Claxton is one of three D-I players – and the only one at a Power 5 school – who leads his team in rebounds, assists, blocks and steals.

- SEC Freshman of the Week – Kentucky guard Tyler Herro, a 6-foot-5, 195-pound freshman from Milwaukee, Wisc., led the Wildcats with a career-high 24 points in a win at Louisville. He reached his career-high total behind a 10-for-13 (.769) day from the floor, including draining a career-high four 3-pointers. Herro also added five boards, an assist, a block and two steals in the rivalry game.

- Tennessee head coach Rick Barnes passed John Wooden on the all-time D-I wins list on Nov. 21. Barnes is 25th on the list with 671 wins. Ralph Miller is 24th with 674 victories.

- Auburn's Bryce Brown's 282 career 3-pointers broke Wesley Person's (262 from 1990-94) school record.

- LSU's Tremont Waters ranks third in the nation with 3.23 steals per game.

- SEC teams won 82.1 percent (64-14) of their games in the month of December.

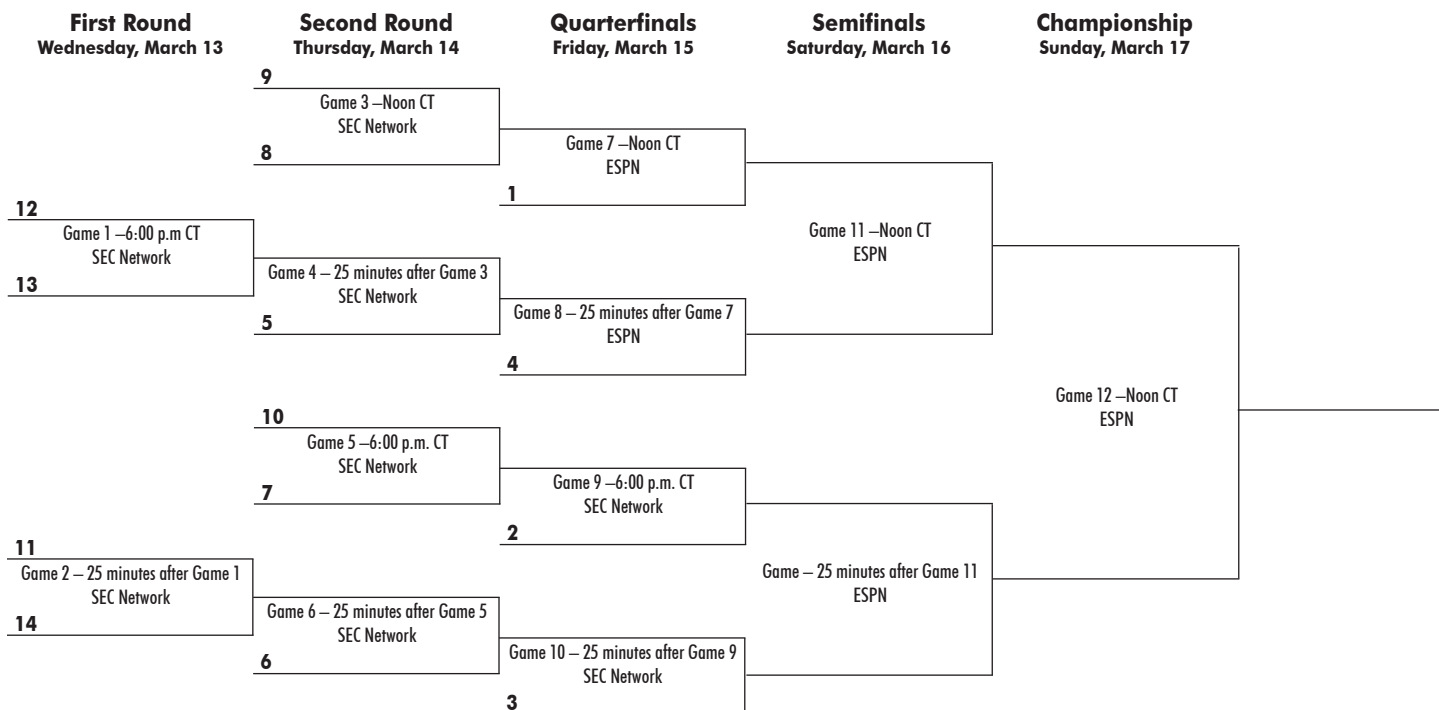

## 2019 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BRIDGESTONE ARENA • NASHVILLE, TENN.



The Southeastern Conference Men's Basketball Tournament returns to Bridgestone Arena in Nashville in 2019. It will be the eighth time that the arena has served as the host of the SEC Tournament, having also hosted in 2001, 2006, 2010, 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017.

Also the home of the NHL's Nashville Predators, Bridgestone Arena has the distinction of being one of the busiest venues in the United States, hosting more than 13 million guests during that time. Seating capacity is approximately 19,395 for basketball games.

It was announced in November 2018 that the SEC extended its agreement with the Nashville Sports Council that could make Music City the home of the SEC Men's Basketball Tournament through 2035. Under the terms of the new agreement, the tournament will be played in Nashville through 2030, with the exception of 2022, with an option to extend the agreement through 2035.

The winner of the 13-game tournament receives the SEC's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-14 based on their regular season conference finish.

Atlanta served as host of the inaugural SEC Tournament played following the 1932-33 season and did so again after the 1933-34 season. The event was held every year through 1952, with the exception of 1935. After a 26-year layoff (1953-78), the tournament was renewed in 1979. The 2018 tournament will be the 59th in league history and the 40th since the renewal.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 25 of the tournament champions since the tournament resumed in 1979

have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Three of the last 13 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. Since the renewal in 1979, the SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only four times.

Kentucky leads the league with 31 SEC Tournament titles. Alabama is second with six, while Tennessee and Florida are tied for third with four. Mississippi State has three championship trophies while Georgia, Ole Miss and Vanderbilt have two. Arkansas, Auburn, LSU and former league member Georgia Tech have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

### SEC Tournament Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Men's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

- A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
- D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

### SEC SUCCESS

#### The Nation's Best Coaches

- All 14 SEC coaches have led their teams to the NCAA Tournament and have combined for 113 NCAA appearances.
- Ten SEC coaches have taken their teams to the Sweet 16, eight have advanced to the Elite Eight and six have gone on to the Final Four (includes Division II).
- Six SEC coaches - Bruce Pearl, Tom Crean, John Calipari, Ben Howland, Frank Martin and Rick Barnes - have been head coaches in the Final Four (includes DI) with two winning national championships.
- The coaches have combined for nearly 5,000 career wins.

#### The Nation's Best Players

- Seven SEC players were picked at the 2018 NBA Draft, including five who were chosen in the first round.
- The 2018 NBA Draft marked the third time (1988 and 2015) that the SEC has had four lottery picks in a single NBA Draft
- The SEC has had at least five first round NBA Draft picks in three of the last four years.
- LSU's Ben Simmons was drafted No. 1 overall in the 2016 NBA Draft. He is the fifth SEC player to be picked first overall in the draft and the fourth in the last eight years.
- The SEC's 23 Lottery Picks since 2010 are the most of any conference.
- Over the last nine NBA Drafts, 65 SEC players have heard their names called. Thirty-nine of those were selected in the first round and four were the No. 1 overall pick.
- Six SEC teams have recruiting classes that rank in the Top 25 of ESPN.com's national rankings - Kentucky (2), LSU (5), Vanderbilt (9), Florida (18), Mississippi State (21) and Arkansas (24).
- Twenty-one players ranked in the Top 100 of ESPN.com's Class of 2018 rankings have signed with SEC schools, including 13 of the Top 50 players in the class and eight of the Top 25.
- Six former SEC players were selected as NBA All-Stars in 2018.

#### Postseason Success

- The SEC's eight NCAA Tournament selections in 2018 are the most in league history. The previous record was six which was accomplished nine times, most recently in 2008.
- The SEC's 10 teams advancing to postseason play in 2018 (8 NCAA, 2 NIT) ties for the most in league history. In 2001, six SEC teams received NCAA Tournament invites while four participated in the NIT.
- SEC teams are 54-30 (64.3 percent) in the NCAA Tournament since 2012 (10-3 in 2012, 4-3 in 2013, 12-3 in 2014, 6-5 in 2015, 3-3 in 2016, 11-5 in 2017 and 8-8 in 2018).
- SEC teams are 31-9 (77.5 percent) in postseason opening games over the last five years (7-0 in 2014, 6-2 in 2015, 5-2 in 2016, 5-3 in 2017 and 7-2 in 2018).
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in 28 of the last 29 years. All of the SEC's 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16 since 1996.
- The SEC has had a team in the Final Four in five of the last eight years.
- Seven different SEC teams (Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State and South Carolina) have appeared in the Final Four.
- The SEC had representatives in both the men's and women's Final Four for the 13th time in 2017.
- Every team in the SEC has made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last 10 editions of the NCAA Tournament.

#### Academics

- A total of 69 men's basketball students were named to the 2017-18 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- 359 men's basketball students have been named to the SEC's Academic Honor Rolls over the last five years.
- LSU's Skylar Mays was a CoSIDA Second Team Academic All-America selection.
