• **Player of the Week:** Mississippi State's Victoria Vivians continued the best start to a season of her career as she averaged 24.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 3.0 steals as Mississippi State defeated host UNLV and No. 22 Syracuse to win the Duel in the Desert Rebel Division and run its record to an impressive 13-0. She also became the third MSU player to score 2,000-career points during the title-clinching win against unbeaten Syracuse. Vivians shot 56.7% from the field, 36.4% from 3-point range and 83.3% from the free-throw line to earn Rebel Division MVP accolades. She opened the week with a 22-point showing against the host Lady Rebels, sparking the Bulldogs with 15 first-quarter points as MSU scored a season-high 36 points in the opening period. Her performance helped State tie the Cox Pavilion scoring record with 103 points. Vivians also got her teammates involved with 4 assists, and on the defensive end she added 3 steals to go with 6 rebounds. In Thursday's title game, a battle of unbeaten against No. 22 Syracuse, Vivians scored 11 first-half points to help MSU jump out to a 44-29 halftime lead. Those 11 first-half points also made her just the third player in school history to reach 2,000-career points, joining LaToya Thomas and Tan White. She helped the Dawgs hold on for the win, netting 8 points in the third quarter on 4-of-6 shooting and 7 points in the final 10 minutes. Vivians also finished a rebound shy of a double-double in the Syracuse contest and also added a trio of steals. Vivians was also named USBWA Player of the Week for her efforts.

• **Freshman of the Week:** Tennessee point guard Evina Westbrook was instrumental in No. 7 Tennessee's 83-71 win over No. 18/24 Stanford on Thursday night, firing in a career-high 17 points and adding four rebounds, a block and a steal. Thanks to the strong performance from the 6-foot standout from Salem, Ore., which was well above her season scoring average, the Lady Vols improved to 12-0 for the first time since the 2005-06 season and for only the fifth time in school history. UT also ended a five-game losing skid at Maples Pavilion, winning at that venue for the first time since Dec. 4, 2005. Westbrook was efficient, connecting on 6 of 9 shots from the field and going 5 of 6 from the charity stripe to finish as UT's second-leading scorer. Three of her four free throws came during the final 2:11, helping UT hold on for the win. Among SEC freshmen, Carter ranks first in scoring and steals, while ranking second in assists. Auburn's Unique Thompson is second in scoring and blocked shots and first in rebounds. Ole Miss' Promise Taylor is first in blocked shots, while Tennessee's Evina Westbrook is first in assists.

• In NCAA stats, USC's A'ja Wilson (5th), Alabama's Ashley Knight (6th), the Rebels Promise Taylor (6th) and UGA's Caliya Robinson (9th) are all in the top ten in blocks. In rebounds, Anriel Howard, Texas A&M is second and MSU's Teaira McCowan is ranked fourth. In team national stats top ten, the Gamecocks are fifth in blocked shots, while the Lady Vols are second in rebounds. Auburn is fifth in steals.

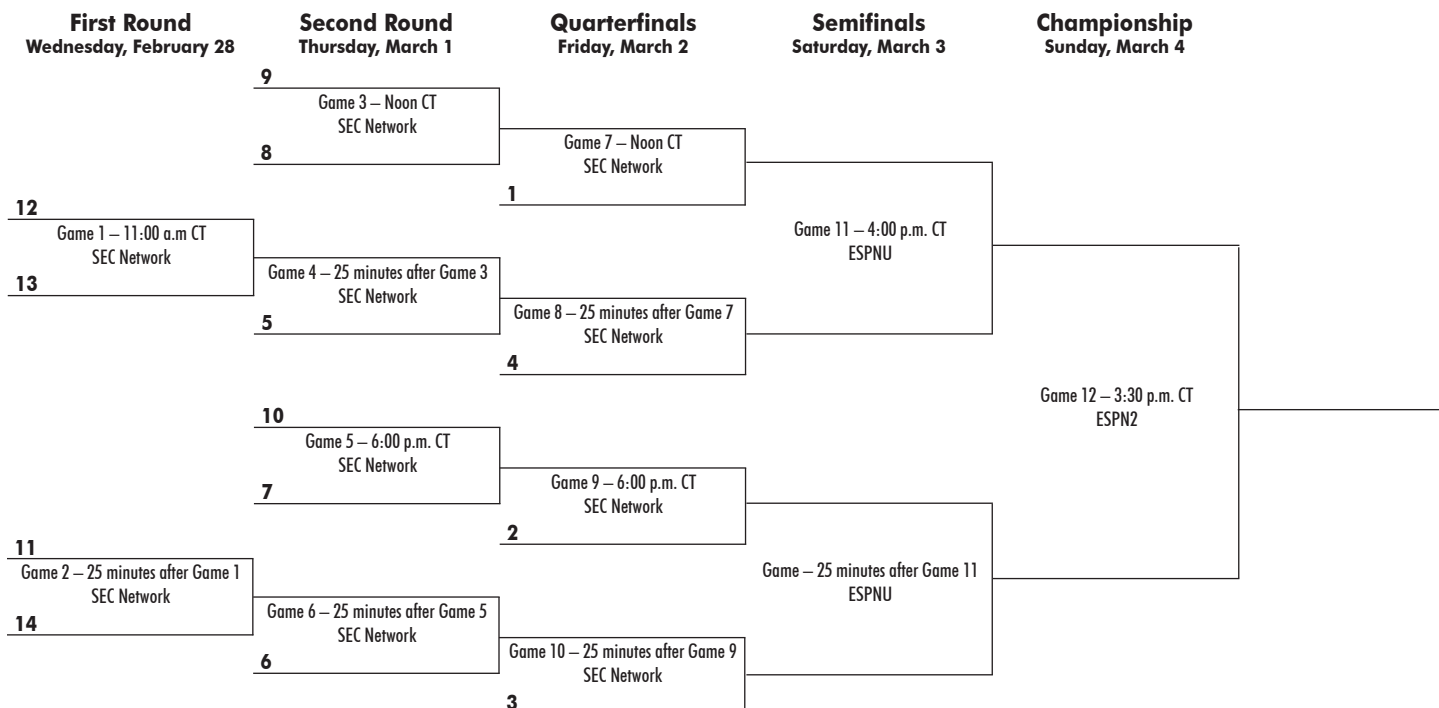

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2018 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BRIDGESTONE ARENA • NASHVILLE, TN



The Southeastern Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will be played for the sixth time in Nashville, Tenn. when Bridgestone Arena plays host to the 2018 event.

Formerly known as the Nashville Arena, the Gaylord Entertainment Center and the Sommet Center, the building became Bridgestone Arena in 2010. Bridgestone Arena opened in December 1996 and has hosted more than 13 million guests. It is Nashville's number one venue for large-scale musical productions, as well as one of the nation's most highly-acclaimed entertainment and sports venues. Seating capacity is approximately 20,000 for concerts, 19,395 for basketball and 17,113 for Nashville Predators games.

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the 13-game tournament will receive the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds and conference champion will be determined by the 16-game regular-season SEC schedule.

The 2017 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament will once again enjoy live television coverage. The SEC Network will televise all first, second and third round games. The semifinals will be aired on ESPNU for the sixth consecutive year, while the championship game will be televised on ESPN2.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Three of the last 10 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. Vanderbilt is second with six, while Georgia and Auburn are tied for third with four. South Carolina has three championship trophies while Kentucky and Texas A&M have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC Tournament Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

- A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
- D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC Success

- With nine national championships, 11 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 37 Final Four appearances and 125 first-team All-America honors, the Southeastern Conference stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the 14 SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament, eight with their respective SEC teams. The two not included in that list are entering their fifth and second season coaching collegiately.
- Eight SEC coaches have taken their teams to the Sweet 16, six have advanced to the Elite Eight and four have gone on to the Final Four.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last seven seasons.
- Eight SEC players were picked in the 2017 WNBA Draft, including four who were chosen in the first round.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Over the last eight WNBA Drafts, 44 SEC players have heard their names called. Fourteen of those were selected in the first round and two were the No. 2 overall pick.
- The last three WNBA MVPs hail from the SEC (Sylvia Fowles: 2015, 2017; Candace Parker: 2016)
- The SEC's 15 wins in the 2017 NCAA Tournament were tied for the most among all conferences.
- The SEC's 2017 NCAA Tournament .682 winning percentage was also tied among leagues with three or more teams in the field.
- 2017 was the 13th time that the SEC had representatives in both the men's and women's Final Four.
- SEC teams have earned appearances in 27 of 36 NCAA Final Fours, an accomplishment unmatched by any other league. The next closest is the Big East with 22 and the ACC with 19.
- Seven different SEC teams (Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State and South Carolina) have appeared in the Final Four.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in every year of NCAA Tournament history. All of the SEC's 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16.
- A total of 88 women's basketball students were named to the 2016-17 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The Women's Basketball Leadership Council is one component of the SEC Student-Athlete Leadership Council.
