• **Player of the Week:** Auburn senior Janiah McKay helped lead the Tigers to three wins in five days, averaging 18.3 points in the Tigers' neutral-site wins over Coastal Carolina and North Carolina, along with a road win at Elon. McKay scored 21 points in both Auburn games in Myrtle Beach at the Carolinas Challenge, leading the Tigers in both contests. In both games, she hit critical free throws late in the game to secure victories for the Tigers. Against North Carolina, her pass to freshman Robyn Benton for a layup with 10 seconds to play tied the game at 69-69 to force overtime, then she scored nine points in the overtime period to cinch an 86-81 victory for the Tigers. Her 21-point efforts against CCU and UNC were her third and fourth straight games with at least 20 points. McKay had four steals in each of the three games this week and currently ranks second in the SEC with 2.5 steals per game.

• **Freshman of the Week:** Kentucky's Rhyn Howard recorded her fifth 20-point scoring game of the season in Kentucky's win over Murray State, posting a game-high 25 points on 9-of-13 shooting with five 3-pointers and four rebounds. The strong performance was her team-leading fourth game this season of 25 points or more and marked the seventh time this season she has led Kentucky in scoring. After just five points in the first half, which saw Kentucky go back and forth against the Racers for the lead, Howard came out of the locker room at halftime and scored 17 points in the third quarter alone to set the tone and put UK in control. She started the week with 18 points, eight rebounds, three steals and three assists against Western Carolina. She leads Kentucky this season in points per game (18.5) and rebounds per game (6.8); sits tied for first in 3-pointers (34) and ranks second in blocks (13) and steals (30). Howard's performances have helped Kentucky shot over 50 percent from the field in three straight games for the first time since the 2013-14 season. She has hit at least one 3-pointer in every game this season and has scored in double figures in 12 of her 13 games.

• Kentucky's Rhyn Howard was also named **USBWA National Freshman of the Week** for her performance last week. It's the first national award for an SEC student-athlete this week.

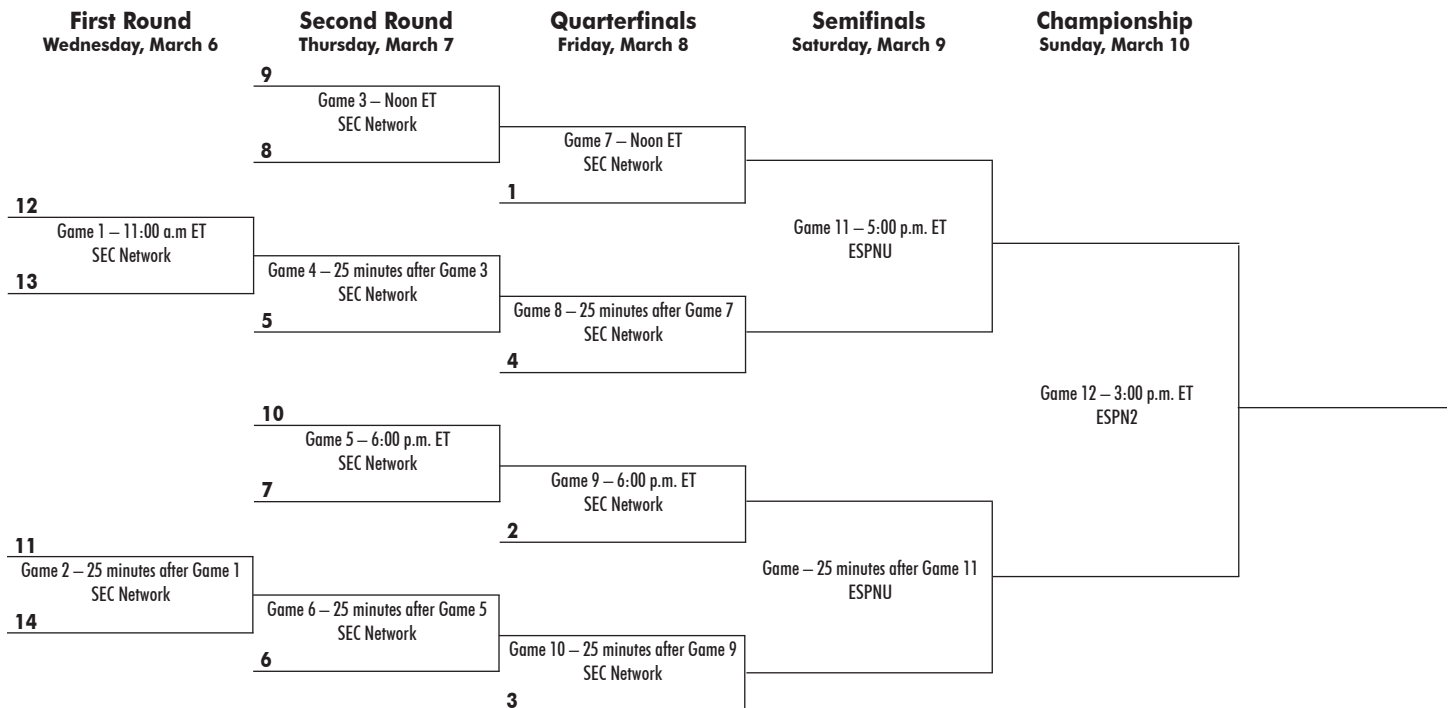

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2019 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BON SECOURS WELLNESS ARENA • GREENVILLE, SC



The Southeastern Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will be played for the third time in Greenville, S.C. when Bon Secours Wellness Arena plays host to the 2019 event.

The Bon Secours Wellness Arena is a state-of-the-art 15,000 seat sports and entertainment venue. The Arena was opened on September 13, 1998 and has hosted award winning musical acts as well as events such as WWE and Disney on Ice. In the fall of 2012, the Greenville City and Greenville County Councils approved funding of \$13.1 million for renovations to the Arena. In June of 2013, the first of a three year renovation project began with phase two starting in June of 2014.

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the 13-game tournament will receive the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds and conference champion will be determined by the 16-game regular-season SEC schedule.

The 2019 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament will once again enjoy live television coverage. The SEC Network will televise all first, second and third round games. The semifinals will be aired on ESPNU for the sixth consecutive year, while the championship game will be televised on ESPN2.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams

in the NCAA Tournament, as 32 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Three of the last 11 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. Vanderbilt is second with six, while Auburn, Georgia, and South Carolina each have four. Kentucky and Texas A&M have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC Tournament Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

- A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
- D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC Notes

- **SEC Success:** With nine national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 38 Final Four appearances and 132 first-team All-America honors, the Southeastern Conference stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a **First-Team All-America** selection in each of the last eight seasons.
- Seven SEC players were picked in the **2018 WNBA Draft**, including three who were chosen in the first round.
- Over the last nine **WNBA Drafts**, 51 SEC players have heard their names called. Seventeen of those were selected in the first round and six were the No. 1 overall pick.
- Five **WNBA Finals MVPs** hail from the SEC (Sylvia Fowles: 2015, 2017; Candace Parker: 2016; Tamika Catchings: 2012; Seimone Augustus: 2011).
- A total of 91 women's basketball students were named to the **2017-18 SEC Academic Honor Rolls** for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- In the **SEC Coaches' Preseason Poll**, Mississippi State tops the order of finish, with South Carolina, Georgia, Tennessee, Missouri, Texas A&M and Kentucky rounding out the top half the league. Auburn, LSU, Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Vanderbilt and Ole Miss round out the bottom half.
- Mississippi State's Teaira McCowan was voted as **SEC Women's Basketball Preseason Player of the Year** by the coaches with Missouri's Sophie Cunningham and Georgia's Caliya Robinson also receiving votes.
- Joining McCowan, Cunningham and Robinson on the **All-SEC Preseason First Team** are Maci Morris, Kentucky; Anriel Howard, Mississippi State; Tyasha Harris, South Carolina; Rennia Davis, Tennessee and Chennedy Carter, Texas A&M.
- The **Coaches' Preseason Second Team All-SEC** is comprised of Malica Monk, Arkansas; Janiah McKay, Auburn; Unique Thompson, Auburn; Taylor Murray, Kentucky; Ayana Mitchell, LSU; Shandricka Sessom, Ole Miss; Amber Smith, Missouri; Alexis Jennings, South Carolina and Evina Westbrook, Tennessee.
- Mississippi State was also voted to win the 2019 SEC championship in a **SEC Media Preseason Poll**. Mississippi State tops the order of finish, with South Carolina, Tennessee, Georgia, Missouri, Texas A&M, and Kentucky rounding out the top half the league. Auburn, LSU, Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Vanderbilt, and Ole Miss round out the bottom half.
- The Bulldog's McCowan was the overwhelming media choice for **SEC Women's Basketball Player of the Year**. Missouri's Sophie Cunningham and Texas A&M's Chennedy Carter also received votes.
- Joining McCowan, Cunningham and Carter on the **Media Preseason All-SEC team** are Georgia's Caliya Robinson, Mississippi State's Anriel Howard, South Carolina's Alexis Jennings and Tennessee's Rennia Davis.
- The **Women's Basketball Leadership Council** is one component of the SEC Student-Athlete Leadership Council.
