ATHLETES OF THE WEEK

Men's Golfer of the Week:

Lorenzo Scalise, Tennessee

- Continued his strong play this season, turning in a runner-up finish at the 3M Augusta Invitational with a 10-under score of 206 to lead Tennessee.
- He put together rounds of 69, 69 and 68 for the two-day tournament and finished one stroke out of first.
- That effort improves him to 20 of 24 rounds at par or better this season, including 13 of 15 during the spring schedule.
- The second-place effort was Scalise's fifth top-five individual finish in Tennessee's last six tournaments and the seventh of his career.
- He recorded a total of 15 birdies and 34 pars during the 3M Augusta Invitational while registering all three rounds under par.
- Has produced Tennessee's top score in all five of the Vols' spring tournaments.
- In March, he was named to the international team for this summer's Arnold Palmer Cup in France.
- Now has seven top-five finishes during his Tennessee career, including five this season.
- Ranks No. 22 in the latest Golfweek Collegiate Men's Rankings.
- His stroke average of 70.21 ranks eighth in the SEC.

Women's Golfer of the Week:

Maddie Szeryk, Texas A&M

- Picked up her third career victory, winning the Bruzzy Challenge by four strokes as the only player to shoot par-or-better in the event.
- Helped the Aggies to their second event win of the season, as Texas A&M shot a 907 (+45) to win by two strokes.
- Extended her streak to seven straight par-or-better rounds before shooting 2-over in the final round.
- Now has finished in the Top 10 in nine of 10 events this season, and in the top five in six of 10 events.
- On pace to break her own single-season stroke average record with a 71.04 average.

Women's Freshman Golfer of the Week:

Ariana Saenz, Texas A&M

- Finished fourth at the Bruzzy Challenge, shooting a 7-over 223, both of which represented career-bests.
- Helped the Aggies to their second event win of the season, as Texas A&M shot a 907 (+45) to win by two strokes.
- Posted a 3-under 69 in the second round, which is her collegiate career-best for a round.
- Registered her first career Top 10 finish at the Bruzzy Challenge.
