## FORENSIC POLYGRAPH REPORT

Ms. Taurasi, was administered a forensic polygraph examination concerning the use of a drug called "Modafinil." 2. Did you lie to club management when you denied ever using the drug Modafinii or any similar generic name brand drug?

Answer: No

3. Did you at any time take the drug Modafinil or any similar generic name brand drug?

Answer: No

The polygraph examination was administered on a Lafayette Instrument LX 4000 Computerized Polygraph. Three polygraph charts were administered, and the polygraph charts were graded using the Backster Numerical Scoring System. The final call is NDI/No Deception Indicated.

Rosemarie Urbanski, MFS, a forensic polygraph examiner, and a full member of the American Polygraph Association, has quality controlled the polygraph examination for accuracy, completeness and grading. Ms. Urbanski concluded after numerically scoring the polygraph charts, that Subject was truthful when she answered "no" to the above relevant questions.
