Arkansas Head Coach Colby Hale

On Arkansas' 4-0 win against Missouri on Monday ...

“I thought the first goal was fantastic. It was a team effort. Cam [Carter] came up big on a couple of saves. They were dangerous. In the first 10 minutes of that second half, we were definitely under a barrage. I thought we weathered it well. We settled in and made some adjustments, and I thought, on the counter, we created quite a few goals. They could have scored another goal or two if Cam hadn't made great saves, but honestly we could have scored a couple more.”

On facing Missouri on Monday after just playing the Tigers last Thursday ...

“It's very tough. I think Arkansas and Missouri are probably going to become rivals in most sports, soccer certainly. It's tough. You can tell it was an emotional game for both teams. We just figured if we came out and worked hard, we liked our chances.”

On Ashleigh Ellenwood, who scored two goals in Monday's match ...

“She's big-time. She's got 13 goals, but it's not just the goals with her. She's a fantastic teammate, she's a great leader, she wins everything in the air, she's a hard worker, she's competitive. The first thing, when you interview her, all she wants to talk about is her teammates. She's an all-around good teammate and it was a complete team effort.”

On facing top-seeded Florida on Wednesday at 5 p.m. CT ...

“They're good. They've won almost every SEC Championship for the past 15-20 years. They're talented, well coached, organized and athletic. They don't have a ton of weaknesses, but our girls fight. It'll be a big challenge, but I think they'll be up for it and we're looking forward to it.”

Arkansas Sophomore Forward Ashleigh Ellenwood

On Arkansas' 4-0 win against Missouri on Monday ...

“I'm really proud of what our team did. We grinded through a lot to have a game on Thursday and then come and play tonight, and have to travel. I'm really just really proud of how we grinded through things and I'm just really proud to be a Razorback.”

On her two goals in Monday's win against Missouri ...

"I am really proud. Jeri [Okoro] worked so hard to get me the ball. Without her, I couldn't be there. It's the work of my teammates. I really appreciate what they do for me."

On Arkansas facing top-seeded Florida on Wednesday ...

"It's going to be a really good match-up and we're going to be ready for them."

On Missouri's 4-0 loss to Arkansas ...

"We came up against an excellent Arkansas team. They were the better team today and they got the win."

On facing Arkansas on Monday after playing the Razorbacks last Thursday ...

"For us, it's whoever is on the jersey. They did a great job. They are well coached and they came to play."

On Missouri's 2013 season ...

"For us, it was a tough season. We had eight overtime games, but our kids fought all the way through regardless of the score. I think we have a lot to build on, but we're going to lose a great group of seniors."
