Senior Wide Receiver Chris Conley

On the cornerback he's most looking forward to matching up against this season...

"No one in particular. I look at games and teams as a whole. There are a lot of teams that I'm ready to play. I think we are, as Georgia, we can't wait to get another jersey, be able to hit somebody different. It's been a long time since we've been able to play some real football. I think that's one of the motivating forces behind this offseason and the reason I can grind like I can. It's just the fact that I have one more season to play in the red and black. It motivates me."

On the difference between Aaron Murray and Hutson Mason's style of play...

"Aaron [Murray] will hate me for saying this, but Hutson [Mason] is taller. That's one difference. But there are not too many differences. Both have tons of experience, they both know the offence to a tee. Hutson has a lot of touch on his pass and Aaron has a lot of zip. That's one of the differences. Hutson is a big guy who anticipates where the ball is going to go and he'll throw before the receiver is open and throw them open. Hutson is definitely a different kind of player, but I don't think there is any drop off in his game play."

On the new attitude in the program this offseason...

"There were a lot of changes that happened. A lot of people who were at Georgia who are not there anymore. I think it was kind of a statement to say we're going to do things the Georgia way and if that's not the way you want to do things then you won't be here. We love those guys, but in order to move forward some changes had to be made. The team really has bought into that and realized what we need to do to get where we want to go. The thing that we can control is ourselves. Moving forward the young guys need to understand that and the older guys have realized it and need to lead with that in mind."
