## SEC Players of the Week

### Offensive Player of the Week

**Krystal Rivers • Alabama**

**Redshirt Sophomore • RS • 5-11 • Birmingham, Ala.**

Rivers posted a pair of double-doubles to lead the Crimson Tide to a 2-0 record in the opening weekend of conference play. She posted 22 kills (a season high for a four-set match) and 10 digs at Georgia. Rivers then reset that season high for kills with 26 against LSU while adding a career-high 12 digs. For the week, she had a .400 hitting percentage, 48 kills, 22 digs and seven total blocks.

### Defensive Player of the Week

**Holly Pole • Florida**

**Senior • DS/L • 5-7 • Ocala, Fla.**

Pole, UF's starting libero, averaged 4.33 digs per set to help the Gators to a 2-0 start in league play. Her digs average is the third highest within conference action after the opening weekend. Pole had no reception errors against Auburn and Ole Miss, and had two of her five service aces this season this past weekend. She now has double-digit digs for UF in seven straight matches.

### Freshman of the Week

**Sydney Deeken • Missouri**

**Freshman • OH • 6-2 • California, Mo.**

Deeken averaged 3.42 points and 2.83 kills per set last weekend to open SEC play, earning her first career starts against Mississippi State and Tennessee. Now in the starting lineup after missing the first three weeks of the season with an abdominal strain, she reset career-highs in kills (10), hitting (.368) and digs (nine) against Mississippi State, and also had career-high attempts (21) and aces (2) against Tennessee. Deeken's 20.5 total points were second on the team last weekend.

## Team Notes

**Alabama:** Alabama opened league play with wins over Georgia and LSU, extending the programs' win streak to nine consecutive victories. In the season-opening win at Georgia, Krystal Rivers led the offense with 22 kills, adding 10 digs for her fourth double-double of the season. Kat Hutson also earned double-digit kills with 14, while Sierra Wilson paced the offense with 52 assists. Leah Lawrence stuffed a team-leading five blocks at the net and Natalie Murison handled 14 digs in the back row. Rivers led the offense once again vs. LSU with 26 kills, notching 12 digs as well for her fifth double-double of the season. Brittany Thomas also posted a double-double, her third of the season, with 13 kills and 10 digs. Wilson set a season-high 57 assists while Bruna Evangelista scored a season-high 11 kills. Next weekend, Alabama hits the road for a pair of matches, first taking on Kentucky (12-2, 2-0 SEC) on Friday, Oct. 3 at 6 p.m. CT before heading to Tennessee (7-9, 0-2 SEC) on Sunday, Oct. 5 for a 12:30 p.m. CT match.

**Arkansas:** The Razorbacks own a 2-0 mark in conference action following wins over Tennessee and Mississippi State to begin the 2014 league season. In Sunday's match against Mississippi State, Arkansas committed just eight attack errors, the fewest by the program since the 2011 season in a match against South Carolina. The Razorbacks were paced by a match-high 11 kills from Meredith Hays and nine kills each by middle blockers Chanell Clark-Bibbs and Ana Sofia Jusino. Samantha Skinner rounded out the balanced attack with seven kills. Defensively, libero Monica Bollinger had a team-high 10 digs behind the block. Clark-Bibbs and Jusino led the team's defensive effort at the net with four blocks apiece. The Razorbacks have one match this week as they visit LSU on Oct. 5 for a 1 p.m. CT match on SEC Network+.

**Auburn:** Auburn dropped both matches to begin SEC play last weekend ... The Tigers (8-7) fell 3-0 (14-25, 19-25, 19-25) on their home floor to 10th-ranked Florida Friday night in front of 1,183 fans, the fifth-best attendance in school history ... No. 22 Texas A&M defeated the Tigers, 3-0 (11-25, 19-25, 15-25), on Sunday in College Station, Texas to round out the opening weekend of conference action ... On Wednesday, Auburn returns home for a midweek ESPNU contest with Georgia with match time set for 8 p.m. at Auburn Arena.

**Florida:** The Gators opened Southeastern Conference play 2-0 following a split weekend with two straight-set sweeps, first at Auburn (25-14, 25-19, 25-19) and then at home against Ole Miss (25-13, 25-15, 25-19) in UF's SEC home opener. On Friday, it was a combination of junior setter Mackenzie Dagostino's distribution to sophomore right side Alex Holston and freshman middle Rhamat Alhassan, as the duo combined for 25 of Florida's 43 kills in the three-set affair, paired with senior Holly Pole's stabilizing back row play that helped UF pump out a .340 attack percentage. Sunday, junior middle blocker Simone Antwi had a career match after turning in a .769 hitting efficiency following 11 kills on 13 swings with just one error. The Gators hit .442 in the match against the Rebels, their best offensive output in conference play since last year at Alabama in October. Six Florida players registered a .300 hitting efficiency or above against Ole Miss. In its first two league matches, UF has limited both opponents to operate under a .200 clip, including a .096 efficiency for Auburn and .197 for Ole Miss. Florida remains undefeated against both the Tigers and Rebels under head coach Mary Wise. Friday's SEC opener made Wise an undefeated 24-0 in conference debuts, each year of her tenure at the helm of the Florida program. The Orange and Blue enter a two-match road swing at LSU (10/3) and at Mississippi State (10/5) at 8-3 overall (2-0 SEC) this week. Both matches will air on the SEC Network. Florida was 16-2 last season in league play and

finished second in the conference standings. Under head coach Mary Wise, Florida is now 360-18 (.952) in conference play after an undefeated weekend. The Gators own 20 SEC Championships, including 18 straight from 1991-2008.

**Georgia:** The Georgia volleyball team suffered a 3-1 (19-25, 28-26, 21-25, 23-25) loss in its Southeastern Conference opener against the University of Alabama Crimson Tide on Wednesday, Sept. 24, at Stegeman Coliseum. Tirah Le'au earned her seventh double-double of the season leading the team in both kills and digs with 19 and 14, respectively. Jasmine Eatmon also had a standout performance with 11 kills and 6 blocks. The Bulldogs will return to action at Auburn next Wednesday, Oct. 3 to play the Tigers at 9 p.m., in an ESPNU televised match.

**Kentucky:** The 14th-ranked Kentucky volleyball team claimed two four-set victories on the road to begin Southeastern Conference action. UK earned a 3-1 win over LSU on Wednesday. The Wildcats were paced by 17 kills from senior Lauren O'Conner and 12 total team blocks to lead the way. Kentucky then followed that with a 3-1 win at South Carolina on Sunday. O'Conner blitzed the Gamecocks for a career-high 22 kills on a career-best .594 hitting percentage with at least 30 attempts in the match. For the week, O'Conner posted 39 kills and committed just nine errors. She averaged 4.88 kills per set and a squad-best 5.19 points per frame. The senior now sits just 18 kills shy of becoming the 15th member of the 1,000-kill club in school history. Kentucky will open its SEC home slate this weekend beginning with a matchup vs. Alabama on Friday, Oct. 3 at 7 p.m. ET. UK will then play host to No. 22 Texas A&M on Sunday, Oct. 5 at 6 p.m. ET. That match will air live on the SEC Network.

**LSU:** LSU is 5-6 on the year and 0-2 in the SEC after dropping matches to Kentucky at home and Alabama on the road. LSU has won three of its last five matches overall, but have dropped the last two after winning the previous three. The Tigers are 4-4 in four set matches and 1-1 in five set matches, having played only one three-set match this season. LSU has dropped the first set in each of the last three matches, but have taken the second in those same matches. LSU has won the second set six times this year as opposed to winning the first set just four times. The team is 2-5 when dropping the first set and 5-5 when tied at 1-1. LSU has gone to extra points in six matches this season, playing in a set going past 30 points for the second time this season in the final set against Alabama. Seven matches this year for LSU have lasted two hours or longer. The 35 points scored by Alabama is the most in a match by an LSU opponent this season and the most scored by an opponent since Auburn in 2011. LSU hit .166 last week, while the opposition hit at a .234 clip. LSU averaged 3.38 blocks per set, accounting for 27, while Alabama and Kentucky combined for just 19 for a 2.38 average. The 17.0 blocks by the Tigers against the Crimson Tide is a team season high, as the 30 blocks assists are tied for the eighth most in a single game by an LSU team. The Tigers have earned double-digit blocks in each of the last eight matches, while out-blocking an opponent in seven of the last eight matches overall. After not having a solo block in each of the first three outings, the Tigers have earned 25 since. The 3.38 average in league play is currently first overall. Briana Holman leads the team averaging 3.93 kills per set, while hitting .371 on the season. Holman earned her first double-double of the season and fifth of her career earning 17 kills with 12 blocks against Alabama. The 12 blocks are tied for the third most in a four-set match in program history, as she is averaging 1.74 per set which currently leads the league. Haley Smith averaged 4.62 digs per set in the two matches last week which is second individually

in the league, currently averaging an even four per set on the season which is sixth. LSU had four players averaging over two kills per set, as Katie Lindelow averaged 2.38, Cati Leak averaged 2.12 and Mimi Eugene averaging 2.20. Emily Ehrle made her season debut against the Crimson Tide and had four kills, two digs and three blocks.

**Ole Miss:** Ole Miss went 0-2 on the weekend, dropping a tough five-setter at South Carolina and then falling to No. 10 Florida 3-0 in Gainesville ... The South Carolina match marked the team's first loss of the season ... The Rebels had a 2-0 lead and a match point in the fourth set, but the Gamecocks rallied to win it 15-12 in the fifth set ... Junior Nakeyta Clair equaled her career-high with 20 kills against South Carolina and hit .395 ... She also had four blocks ... Freshman Taylor Alexander got her first start of the year against South Carolina and finished with nine kills, hit .375 and tallied four blocks ... The Rebels return home to host Missouri Wednesday at 6 p.m. ... The Game will be broadcast on the SEC Network.

**Mississippi State:** On the road to open conference play for the first time since 2010, the Mississippi State volleyball Bulldogs fell in a pair of 3-0 decisions at Missouri and Arkansas this past weekend. Despite the sweeps, the Bulldogs had several standout players. Chelsea Duhs paced MSU throughout both matches in kills, while Shelby Anderton led State in assists. Anderton capped her weekend with a season-high 24 assists against the Razorbacks. Also, Sunday's match marked the 100th SEC match for head coach Jenny Hazelwood. The Bulldogs now return home to face South Carolina and top-10 for Florida at Newell-Grissom. MSU faces USC at 7 p.m. CT on Friday, Oct. 3, on SEC Network+. The Bulldogs and Gators will clash on Sunday, Oct. 5, at 1 p.m., on the SEC Network. Sunday's match will mark MSU volleyball's first appearance on the SEC Network.

**Missouri:** Mizzou is 2-0 in the SEC after earning wins over Mississippi State and Tennessee. Sophomore outside hitter Carly Kan recorded 14 kills and 10 digs on Friday vs. Mississippi State in her national-best 12th double-double. Joining Kan in leading the winning effort was Sydney Deeken, who tallied a career-best 10 kills in her first start as a Tiger. Deeken also added nine digs, finishing one short of a double-double. On Sunday against Tennessee, senior All-American Whitney Little registered nine kills, hitting at an efficient .471 clip. She is second among active Division I players in career hitting percentage. Fellow senior Sarah Meister recorded a career-high five aces. Defensively, Meister posted 13 digs, moving to fifth all-time in school history for career digs with 1,285. The Tigers will hit the road to face Ole Miss at 6 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 1. The match will be televised on the SEC Network. Mizzou will then take on host Georgia on Sunday, Oct. 5 for a 3 p.m. match live on the SEC Network.

**South Carolina:** The Gamecocks went 1-1 on their first weekend of SEC play as they handed Ole Miss its first loss of the season with a 3-2 win on Friday before falling to No. 14 Kentucky, 3-1, on Sunday. Carolina is now 11-3 on the season. The Gamecocks lost the first two sets against Ole Miss before winning the last three, marking the first time Carolina has done that since rallying from a 2-0 deficit to defeat Alabama at home on Nov. 13, 2005. Junior setter Kellie McNeil fell one dig shy of a triple-double on Friday as she recorded 38 assists, 10 kills (.667), nine digs and six blocks. On the weekend she averaged 1.44 kills, 8.67 assists, 1.56 digs and 1.00 blocks per set. Freshman outside hitter Taylr McNeil had another solid weekend, averaging 3.44 kills per set, with 18 kills and Friday and 13 on Sunday. Carolina returns to action on the road next weekend as it will play at Mississippi State on Friday

and at Auburn on Sunday.

**Tennessee:** Tennessee (7-9, 0-2 SEC) opened conference play on the road last weekend, falling by identical 3-0 score lines at both Arkansas and Missouri. The pair of losses marked the first time since 2002 that the Lady Vols have been swept in back-to-back matches to open the league campaign. Freshman outside hitter Kendra Turner paced UT offensively in both matches, registering a team-high nine kills against the Razorbacks and eight against the Tigers on Sunday. For the season, Turner averages 2.74 kills per set, just 0.08 kills per set fewer than team leader Jamie Lea. The sophomore Lea was second in kills in both matches as well, posting eight and six in each match, respectively. In Friday's match at Arkansas, defensive specialist Claudia Coco made her first career start at libero bringing the total of freshmen in the starting lineup to a season-high five. Coco joined Turner, middle blocker Ilesha Bryant, right side Kanisha Jimenez, and outside hitter Kelsey Bawcombe in the starting group that night. All six true freshmen on the squad have now seen game action as rookie setter Sabrina Tavakoli made her season debut on Sunday. Tennessee went 5-8 in the month of September. The Lady Vols will host Texas A&M in their SEC home opener on Friday night before welcoming Alabama to Thompson-Boling Arena on Sunday. The pair of matches kick off a four-game homestand for Tennessee -- its longest of the season. UT faced both programs on the road last season and dropped 3-0 decisions in each match. The Lady Vols lead the series with the Aggies 6-4, but are 3-4 over the last seven meetings. Meanwhile, Alabama's 3-0 win over UT last season snapped a 10-match winning streak in the series for the Orange and White.

**Texas A&M:** Texas A&M (9-3) went 2-0 last week, defeating Texas-A&M Corpus Christi, 3-1, in the Aggies' final non-conference match and then opening SEC play with a 3-0 victory against Auburn on Sunday. Junior middle blocker Shelby Sullivan posted back-to-back career highs in kills and points with 19 kills and 20.5 points against the Islanders and 20 kills and 25 points against Auburn, breaking A&M records for kills and points in a three-set SEC match. She also hit a career-high .826 -- 20 kills and only one error in 23 attempts -- against the Tigers, setting the Reed Arena record and an A&M SEC record for hitting percentage when making 10 or more attack attempts. As a team, A&M hit a season-high .440 hitting percentage against Auburn, breaking the school record for hitting percentage in a three-set SEC match. Freshman setter Stephanie Aiple averaged 12.71 assists per set as the Aggie offense hit a combined .344 for the week. The Round Rock, Texas, native had a career-high 15 digs and posted the first double-double of her career as she also tallied 54 assists in the victory against TAMU-CC. Her 54 assists were two shy of her career-high 56 assists in a five-set victory over No. 6 USC earlier this season. For the season, Aiple is averaging 10.78 assists per set, ranking fifth overall in the SEC and leading all SEC freshmen setters. Fifth-year senior Sydney Wilhelm, an outside hitter who is in her first season as a member of a varsity intercollegiate team, came off the bench against TAMU-CC and sparked the Aggies with 11 kills and 11 digs, marking her first career double-double. Sophomore outside hitter Emily Hardesty tallied her second double-double with 12 kills and 18 digs against the Islanders. The Aggies make their first SEC road trip of the season this weekend, taking on Tennessee in Knoxville on Friday and facing No. 14 Kentucky in Lexington on Sunday in a match that will be televised on the SEC Network. The 2014-15 academic year marks the 40th season of women's varsity athletics at Texas A&M. As part of a year-long celebration, numerous recognitions and activities will be held leading up to the official 40th anniversary date on June 15, 2015.
