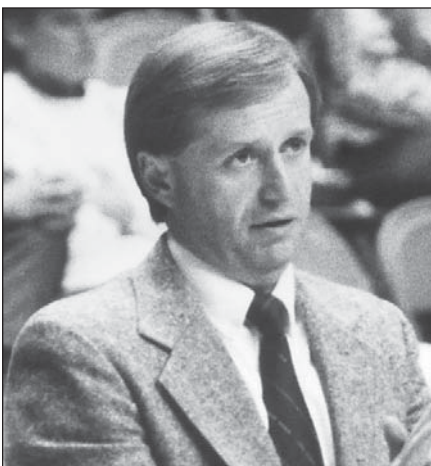
SEC TOURNAMENT



In 1980, the Tennessee Lady Vols captured the first-ever SEC Tournament Championship with an 85-71 victory over Ole Miss. Through the years, Tennessee has compiled the most victories in the competition, posting an overall record of 73-18 in tournament play, and the most tournament titles with 17.
