ALABAMA NOTES

- Alabama is now 13-19 overall, 25-36 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- The Crimson Tide finish the season on a six-game winless streak.
- Sophomore forward Ashley Williams scored 21 points, leading the Tide in scoring for the 13th time this season.
- It was Williams' sixth game with 20+ points and 21st double-figure game this season.
- Junior forward Nikki Hegstetter scored 10 points for her fifth game in double figures.
- Freshman guard Hannah Cook led Alabama with seven rebounds.
- Alabama won the battle of bench points, 15-12

VANDERBILT NOTES

- Vanderbilt is now 15-15 on the season.
- The Commodores are now 46-29 all-time in the SEC Tournament, 7-2 in tournament games played in Little Rock.
- Tonight's win snaps a three-game winless streak for the Commodores.
- Freshman guard Rebekah Dahlman led Vanderbilt with 16 points, the ninth time she has led the Commodores this season. It was the 12th game in double figures for Dahlman and first since VU's 76-75 win at Florida on Feb. 19.
- Freshman guard Paris Kea also scored 16, while sophomore forward Marqu'es Webb had 14, the eighth time each has reached the double-figures mark this season.
- This marked the 16th time this season Vanderbilt has had three or more players score in double figures.
- Junior guard Morgan Batey led the Commodores with nine rebounds, the seventh time she has led VU in boards this season.
- Vanderbilt outscored Alabama 32-28 in the paint and 6-0 o the fast break.
