

AUBURN NOTES

- Auburn is now 13-17 overall, 36-31 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- After an 0-13 start in SEC play this season, the Tigers have now won four straight games, dating back to a 44-26 victory over Georgia on Feb. 22.
- AU snapped a five-game losing streak in the series with Florida, dating back to Jan. 6, 2011.
- The 22-point margin was the largest for Auburn over an SEC opponent this season and the largest win over an SEC foe since defeating Alabama, 61-39 (22 points) on Jan. 16, 2014.
- The 22-point margin of victory is higher than Auburn's previous largest lead at any point in an SEC game this season. The Tigers led by as many as 24 points, passing the previous high of 21 against Georgia and Alabama.
- Auburn has scored 70+ points the last three games after a stretch of 15 games without surpassing 60.
- The Tigers are 11-0 this season when scoring at least 60 points.
- Sophomore guard Brandy Montgomery led Auburn with 22 points, the ninth time this season she has paced the Tigers in points.
- This was the seventh 20+ point game of the season for Montgomery, the ninth of her career.
- Auburn won the battle of points in the paint, 38-28.

FLORIDA NOTES

- Florida finishes the season with a 13-17 overall record.
- The Gators are now 19-35 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- This marks the first time since 2010 that Florida will not appear in the SEC Tournament quarterfinals.
- Tonight's loss snaps a five-game Florida winning streak over Auburn.
- The 19 first-half points scored by UF tied for the second-fewest for the team in an opening half this season. Florida scored 17 in the first half against South Carolina and 19 at Georgia.
- The first half marked the eighth time this season Florida has scored 22 points or fewer in a half in 2014-15.
- Sophomore forward Ronni Williams led Florida with 16 points, her team-best 18th double-figure game.
- Williams is the only Gator to have scored in all 30 games and led UF in scoring for the eighth time.
- Williams also pulled down a team-high 12 rebounds, the eighth time this season she led UF in rebounds.
- Florida's bench doubled-up its Auburn counterpart in points, 30-15.
