



## 2015 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament

Game 6 – Thursday, March 5 – 7:30 p.m.

#6 Kentucky 67, #11 Vanderbilt 61

### KENTUCKY NOTES

---

- Kentucky is now 22-8 overall, 30-35 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- The Wildcats have now won three straight games and advance to face Mississippi State in the quarterfinals on Friday.
- Senior guard Jennifer O'Neill led the Wildcats with 19 points, her 25<sup>th</sup> game in double figures this season and sixth in a row.
- O'Neill hit four 3-pointers, the most since she hit five against Auburn on Jan. 8.
- Sophomore guard Linnae Harper scored 18, her 26<sup>th</sup> double-figure game in 2014-15.
- Senior center Azia Bishop had two blocked shots to give her 52 on the season, tying her for fifth on the UK single-season list.
- The Wildcats outrebounded the Commodores 41-31.
- UK won the battle of points in the paint, 36-28, and bench points, 31-7.

### VANDERBILT NOTES

---

- Vanderbilt is now 15-16 on the season.
- The Commodores are now 46-30 all-time in the SEC Tournament, 7-3 in tournament games played in Little Rock.
- Vanderbilt falls to 11-3 on the season when leading at halftime.
- Sophomore forward Marqu'es Webb led Vanderbilt by tying a career high with 18 points, her ninth game in double figures and fifth in a row.
- Freshman guard Rebekah Dahlman scored 10 points, her 12<sup>th</sup> game in double figures and pulled down 10 rebounds, tying a career high.
- The 10 point, 10 rebound performance gave Dahlman the second double-double of her career.
- Junior guard Jasmine Jenkins scored a season-high 12 points, her second double-figure game.
- Freshman guard Paris Kea scored 10 for her ninth game with 10+ points.
- This marked the fifth time this season Vanderbilt has had four or more players score in double figures, the second time against an SEC opponent (Mississippi State 1/11/15).
