

2015 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament Game 4 – Thursday, March 5 – 2:30 p.m. #5 Texas A&M 57, #13 Auburn 47

TEXAS A&M NOTES

- Texas A&M is now 23-8 overall, 5-1 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- A&M is now 7-0 against Auburn, 2-0 in the SEC Tournament and have defeated the Tigers in each of the last two events.
- The Aggies were 0-2 from 3-point range, tying a season low in makes set in seven other games.
- Junior Courtney Williams led A&M with 14 points, her 21st game in double figures, and eighth straight.
- Junior guard Courtney Walker, senior forward Achiri Ade and junior guard Chelsea Jennings each had 10 points for A&M. It was the 14th game with 10+ for Walker, the eighth for Ade and the fourth for Jennings.
- The game marked the fifth time this season Texas A&M had four or more players score in double figures.
- Texas A&M's bench outscored Auburn's 12-3.

AUBURN NOTES

- Auburn is now 13-18 overall, 36-34 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- Neither team hit a 3-pointer in the first half, sophomore forward Katie Frerking's trey with 19:18 left in the second period was the only three for either side in the contest.
- Auburn did not attempt a free throw in the first half.
- Junior forward Tra'Cee Tanner led Auburn with 14 points, the 15th time this season she has led the Tigers in scoring.
- Frerking scored 13 points and pulled down 10 rebounds for her first career double-double and the seventh double-double by a Tiger this season.
- This was the 11th time this season that Frerking led the Tigers in rebounding.
- Auburn won the battle of points in the paint, 36-32.
