SOUTH CAROLINA NOTES

- South Carolina is now 29-2 overall, 10-23 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- The Gamecocks advance to face the winner of Tennessee-Kentucky in the final on Sunday.
- This will be South Carolina's first appearance in the SEC Tournament Championship Game.
- USC is a perfect 6-0 this season in neutral-site games.
- The Gamecocks are now 13-0 when scoring 70+ points.
- South Carolina's winning margin of 20 points marked the ninth SEC game this year with a 20+ margin for the Gamecocks.
- The Gamecocks won their fifth game this season after trailing at the half, now 5-2 in those games.
- The Gamecocks outrebounded the Razorbacks, 36-25. USC has won the rebounding battle against every SEC opponent this season and has done so by 10+ rebounds in 17 games.
- Sophomore center Alaina Coates scored a team-high 16 for her 19th game in double figures.
- Senior forward Aleighsa Welch scored 11 points and pulled down a team-best 10 rebounds for her third double-double of the season.
- South Carolina's bench outscored its LSU counterparts 46-5, and dominated points in the paint, 34-16.

LSU NOTES

- LSU is now 17-13 overall, 34-35 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- This was just the third time the Tigers have lost after holding a halftime lead this season.
- LSU is now 16-3 when leading at the half.
- LSU had just five points off the bench.
- Sophomore guard Raigyne Moncreif scored 20 points to record her team-best 21st double-figure game of the season.
- Senior guard DaShawn Harden scored 19 points for her 14th game in double figures.
