

2015 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament Game 12 – Saturday, March 7 – 6:30 p.m. #2 Tennessee 75, #6 Kentucky 64

TENNESSEE NOTES

- Tennessee is now 27-4 overall, 75-18 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- The Lady Volunteers advance to the championship game for the 23rd time, where they will face the No. 1 seed South Carolina.
- Tennessee was without a field goal for the opening 7:19 of the game, the first make was a three from Jordan Reynolds at the 12:41 mark.
- UT is now a perfect 21-0 when leading at halftime.
- Senior forward Cierra Burdick scored 20 points lead UT, her second game this season with 20+ points and 17th in double figures.
- Burdick also pulled down a team-best 11 rebounds for her seventh doubledouble this season.
- Sophomore guard Andraya Carter scored 12 points, her 10th double-figure game of the season.
- Junior forward Bashaara Graves dished out a career-high five assists while adding six points, nine rebounds and two blocks.
- UT outrebounded the Wildcats, 41-38. Tennessee is now 23-1 when outrebounding the opponent.

KENTUCKY NOTES

- Kentucky is now 23-9 overall, 31-36 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- Senior guard Bria Goss led the Wildcats with 16 points, her 12th game in double figures this season.
- Sophomore guard Linnae Harper scored 15, her 21st double-figure game this season.
- Senior guard Jennifer O'Neill scored 11 points, her 27th game in double figures this season and seventh in a row.
- Sophomore guard Makayla Epps also scored in double figures with 10.
- UK is now 8-2 on the year when four or more players score in double figures.
- Kentucky forced 20 turnovers, the 23rd time the Wildcats have forced 20 or more, they are now 19-4 in those games.
- UK won the battle of points in the paint, 28-20 and bench points, 25-15.
