Second Round – Game #5 Notes

Tennessee 67, Vanderbilt 61

Tennessee will play No. 2 seed Arkansas Friday at 6:00 p.m. CT.

Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Tennessee leads 115-73.
- Season Series: Tennessee leads 2-1
- SEC Tournament: Tennessee 7-1
- Vanderbilt defeated Tennessee in the last meeting in Knoxville 73-65 on February 26.

Game Notes:

- With Tennessee leading 18-16 at the 10:37 mark in the first half, Vanderbilt reeled off a 20-7 run to take a 36-25 advantage with 2:46 left in the half.
- Trailing 47-34 at the 16:54 mark of second half, Tennessee went on an 11-0 run over the next 4:36 to pull within two at 47-45. The Volunteers responded with a 12-2 run.
- The back-and-forth contest continued with a 17-2 Tennessee run that gave the Volunteers their first lead of the second half at 64-61 with 2:10 left in the game.
- Tennessee capitalized on 12 Vanderbilt turnovers to score 17 compared to just 8 points off turnovers for the Commodores.

Vanderbilt Notes:

- Vanderbilt falls to 19-13 and ends a five-game win streak.
- Damian Jones posted his seventh double-double of his career, second of the year and first since the season opener with 20 points and 15 rebounds. The 15 rebounds are a career high.
- Luke Kornet tied his career high in assist with 4.

Tennessee Notes:

- Tennessee improves to 16-15 and has won two of its last three.
- Josh Richardson tallied his third 20-point game in his last 5 with 22 points.
- Richardson reached the 20-point plateau in all three meetings with Vanderbilt this year.
- Devon Baulkman recorded his fifth double-digit game with 12 points.
- Robert Hubbs totaled 16 points to tie his career high.
