Second Round – Game #6 Notes South Carolina 60, Ole Miss 58

South Carolina will play No. 3 seed Georgia Friday at approximately 8:30 p.m. CT.

Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Ole Miss leads 18-16
- Season Series: Tied at 1-1
- SEC Tournament: Tied at 4-4
- Ole Miss defeated South Carolina in Oxford 65-49 on January 10.

Game Notes:

- With both Auburn and South Carolina victorious today, both first-round winners have advanced to the quarterfinals since the SEC Tournament moved to a 14-team bracket.
- Carolina opened the game with a 12-3 run in the first 5:01. Ole Miss responded with an 8-1 run over the last 2:30 of the half to trim its deficit to 27-24 at halftime.
- The Rebels scored the game's first bucket and did not lead again until the final 6:07 when they took a 45-44 lead.
- Both teams struggled from the field shooting 30 percent.
- Ole Miss enjoyed a 44-33 edge in rebounds and a 25-7 advantage in bench points.

Ole Miss Notes:

- Ole Miss falls to 20-12.
- The Rebels snap a three-game SEC Tournament win streak in Nashville.
- The 58 points was Ole Miss' second-lowest total of the year.
- The Rebels recorded a season-high 21 turnovers.
- LaDarius White scored a game-high 17 points and is averaging 16.0 over his last three games.
- White connected on four 3-pointers (4-of-6) for the second time in the last three games.

South Carolina Notes:

- South Carolina improves to 17-15 and has won four of its last five games.
- Carolina is 4-1 in its last four SEC Tournament games and advances to the quarterfinals for the second straight game.
- Michael Carrera posted a team-high 16 points, one shy of his season high. He is averaging 14.5 over his last four games.
