### Quarterfinals – Game #7 Notes

Kentucky 64, Florida 49

**Kentucky will play the winner of LSU/Auburn Saturday at noon CT.**

#### Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Kentucky leads 97-37
- Season Series: Kentucky leads 3-0
- SEC Tournament: Kentucky leads 4-2
- The teams have played in the SEC Tournament four of the last five years.

#### Game Notes:

- After Florida took an early 12-7, Kentucky responded with a 13-5 run to take a 20-17 lead at the 7:54 mark of the first half. The Wildcats never trailed again and led by as much as 17.
- Free throws were 19-of-23 for Kentucky and 3-for-5 for Florida.
- The Wildcats were in single-digit turnovers for the fifth straight game with seven, which is the fewest forced by the Gators this year.

#### Kentucky Notes:

- Kentucky improves to 32-0.
- The Wildcats have tied their longest win streak in school history. UK was 25-0 in 1953-54 and opened the 1954-55 campaign 7-0.
- Kentucky held its opponent under 55 points for the 20<sup>th</sup> time this season.
- Karl-Anthony Towns posted his seventh double-double of the year with 13 points and 12 rebounds.
- Towns is shooting 67.3 percent in his last eight games.

#### Florida Notes:

- Florida falls to 16-17 and loses for just the second time in the last five games.
- The Gators suffer their first losing season since 1997-98.
- Jon Horford finished two shy of his career high with 15 points. It marked his third double-digit scoring game in his last six outings.
- Dorian Finney-Smith's four points matched his lowest scoring output in the last 10 games.
