Quarterfinals – Game #10 Notes

Georgia 74, South Carolina 62

Georgia will play Arkansas Saturday at approximately 2:30 p.m. CT.

Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Georgia leads 55-50
- Season Series: South Carolina leads 2-1
- SEC Tournament: Georgia leads 2-0
- The teams last met in the semifinals of the 1997 SEC Tournament, won by UGA 78-63 in Memphis.

Game Notes:

- There were four ties and two lead changes over the final 13:54.
- Georgia led for 32:02 of the game and was ahead by as much as 12 early in the second half.
- South Carolina scored the game's first basket and did not lead again until the 11:35 mark of the second half when a 13-2 run gave USC a 44-43 advantage.
- Points in the paint were 34-20 in favor of Georgia.
- UGA led in fastbreak points, 10-0.

Georgia Notes:

- Georgia improves to 21-10 and has won five of its last six games.
- The Bulldogs advance to the SEC Tournament semifinals for the second straight year.
- Marcus Thornton led four Bulldogs in double figures with 15 points.
- Yante Maten posted his first career double-double with 13 points, which tied his career high, and a career-best 10 rebounds. It marked his fifth double-digit scoring performance of the season.

South Carolina Notes:

- South Carolina falls to 16-16 and loses for just the second time in its last five games.
- Carolina is 3-2 in its last five SEC Tournament games.
- Duane Notice notched his third 20-point game of the year and first since December with a game-high 20.
- Sindarius Thornwell matched his season high with six assists to go with 10 points and five rebounds.
- Laimonas Chatkevicius posted his most points in five games with 10.
