



## 2015 SEC Men's Basketball Tournament

### Semifinals – Game #12 Notes

Arkansas 60, Georgia 49

**Arkansas will play Kentucky in the SEC Tournament Final Sunday at noon CT.**

#### Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Arkansas leads 20-14
- Season Series: Arkansas leads 2-0
- SEC Tournament: Arkansas leads 6-3
- Arkansas won the lone regular-season meeting 79-75 in Athens.

#### Game Notes:

- Arkansas never trailed in the game and led by as much as 19.
- With the game tied at 12-12 at the 5:42 mark of the first half, the Razorbacks went on an 11-2 run to pull ahead by nine.
- After Georgia pulled within seven with 17:01 remaining, Arkansas reeled off a 15-3 run over the next four minutes to pull away. The Bulldogs did not get closer than nine the rest of the way.
- Second chance points were 16-3 in favor of Arkansas.

#### Arkansas Notes:

- Arkansas improves to 26-7 and has won three of their last four games.
- The Razorbacks advance to the SEC Tournament finals for the first time since 2008 and sixth time in their history.
- Arkansas is 6-6 all-time in the SEC Tournament semifinals and is 5-1 in their last six.
- Michael Qualls led the Razorbacks with 15 points.
- Bobby Portis posted double-digit rebounds for the third straight game with 12. His four points was a season low and snapped a school-record streak of 27 straight games in double figures.

#### Georgia Notes:

- Georgia falls to 21-11 and loses for just the second time in their last seven games.
- The Bulldogs are 4-7 all-time in the SEC Tournament semifinals and have dropped their last two.
- Marcus Thornton notched his ninth career double-double and sixth of the year with 13 points and 12 rebounds.
- Cameron Forte scored a season-high 13 points.
- Taylor Echols posted career-best 10 points.
