Junior Quarterback Jeremy Johnson

On his approach to being Auburn's quarterback

"My approach is to just stay humble. I'm blessed to be in this situation. I'm blessed to have this opportunity to be the quarterback at Auburn University. I'm just ready to lead my team each and every game, and just try to be ready every game."

On how the offense will change with him at quarterback

"The offense is pretty much going to be the same. We're still going to run the ball. The offense is going to be amazing this year. We've got a lot of weapons around me and I feel comfortable."

On how confident he feels with his abilities

"I have a lot of confidence. We have probably the best wide receiver in the country right now (Duke Williams), but not only him, we've got Ricardo Louis and Melvin Ray. That's three seniors and then we've got Marcus Davis, a junior that's been playing since he was a freshman. I've just got a lot of weapons around me, and like I said, those guys are going to make a lot of plays for me this year, so I feel very, very good about it."

On how comfortable he is with Malzahn's offense

"I've been in this system for three years now. Even when I wasn't playing I've always been competing as a starter. My time is here now and I'm blessed. I've been preparing for a start since I got to Auburn, so I felt like a starter but I wasn't playing, and now that my time is here I can release everything that I had inside me while I was sitting out those two years."

On which freshman he is most excited about

"Kerryon Johnson. He's playing running back, but he has the ability to play receiver and play wildcat. He's a great athlete. He has tremendous hands. He comes out of the backfield and has good speed. He's going to help us a lot this year in this offense."
