On His Role Deciding To Play On The Left Or Right Side of the Offensive Line

“Well, I started the spring playing some on the left after playing right the season before. I played the right the second half of the spring, I’m just moving around and trying some different offensive line combinations. But, wherever they (coaches) put me at I’ll play. I can play effectively in both spots. Wherever I do play, I will play it well and have the best season of my career.”

On Playing The First Game Against Arizona State in Houston, Texas

“It means everything, especially being about ten minutes from my house. It’s a true blessing to be able to play the first game of my fourth year in college at that stadium. It’s going to be a great atmosphere and what makes it better is that it’s going to be an hour and a half from Aggieland, so the fans get to travel and see us play.”
