

2016 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament Game 3 – Thursday, March 3 – 12:00 p.m. #9 Auburn vs. #8 Missouri

TOURNAMENT NOTES

- The 94 combined points marks the lowest total in an SEC Tournament game since 2012, when LSU defeated Arkansas, 41-40, in the quarterfinals
- Auburn's two-point margin of victory is the lowest in any SEC Tournament second round game since the tournament expanded in 2013

AUBURN NOTES

- Auburn's all-time SEC Tournament record improves to 37-34
 - The Tigers are now 3-3 in SEC Tournament play under fourth-year head coach Terry Williams-Flournoy
- Auburn will make its second SEC Tournament quarterfinals appearance in the last five seasons—it also reached the quarterfinals in 2014
- This is the third consecutive year the Tigers have won an SEC Tournament game
- Auburn's 47 points were its fewest in a victory since it won at Georgia, 44-26, on Feb. 22, 2015
- For the seventh time this season, Auburn finished with fewer than two three-pointers

 Auburn is now 3-4 in such games this season
- Auburn improved to 4-0 this season when committing 10 or fewer turnovers
- The Tigers are now 8-0 when accruing 13-plus steals this season
- For only the sixth time this season, Auburn won a game in which Brandy Montgomery, Katie Frerking, Tra'Cee Tanner combined for less than 40 points
 - Prior to this afternoon, Auburn had a 5-10 record in such games

MISSOURI NOTES

- Missouri remains winless in its four SEC Tournament appearances
 - Missouri has been the higher seed in its last three SEC Tournament losses
- Prior to this afternoon, Missouri was 5-0 this season when it made at least nine threepointers in a game
- Missouri held its opponent to fewer than two three-pointers for the sixth time this season, but it lost one of those games for just the second time
- The Tigers were held to less than 36-percent shooting for just the fifth time this season
- Missouri missed each of its last four field goals and six of its final seven attempts
- Senior guard Morgan Stock's team-high 17 points matched her second-highest scoring output of the season
- Stock matched her season high with five three-pointers
 - It was also the second time this season Stock shot better than 50 percent from distance when she attempted at least eight threes
