Second Round – Game #2 Notes Florida 68, Arkansas 61

Florida advances to face Texas A&M Friday at noon CT

Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Florida leads 20-11
- SEC Tournament: Florida leads 4-1
- Season Series: Florida leads 2-0
- Florida has won five straight in the series.

Game Notes:

- There were seven ties and seven lead changes in the game.
- Trailing 21-20 with 3:19 left in the first half, Florida went on a 19-8 run over the next 6:12 to take a 39-29 lead and never trailed again. UF led by as much as 11.
- Down 55-46 with 6:45 left, the Razorbacks used a 13-5 run, including a stretch of six straight points, to pull within one at 60-59 with 1:07 left. The Gators countered with six straight points of their own to secure the win.
- Arkansas connected on just 2-of-12 3-pointers (16.7 percent), while Florida was 8-of-20 (40.0 percent) from behind the line.
- The Gators enjoyed a 28-5 edge in bench points.

Florida Notes:

- Florida improves to 19-13 and has won two straight games after a four-game skid.
- Kasey Hill came off the bench for a season-high 18 points, which is two shy of his career high. It marked the fourth time this year for him to lead the Gators in scoring. He also led the squad with five assists.
- Dorian Finney-Smith reached double-digit points for the 17th time in his last 19 games with 13 while adding nine boards.

Arkansas Notes:

- Arkansas falls to 16-16 and has dropped two straight games after a four-game winning streak.
- Dusty Hannahs led all scorers with a career-high 33 points. It marked his 13th performance of 20 or more points this season. He has scored in double figures in seven straight outings.
- Moses Kingsley registered his fifth double-double in the last eight games and 16th of the season with 10 points and 14 rebounds.
- Jabril Durham collected six assists to top 200 for the season (204). He becomes the fourth Razorback all-time to achieve the feat.
