Second Round – Game #3 Notes Tennessee 67, Vanderbilt 65

Tennessee advances to face LSU Friday at approximately 2:30 p.m. CT

Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Tennessee leads 117-74
- SEC Tournament: Tennessee leads 8-1
- Season Series: Vanderbilt leads 2-1

Game Notes:

- There were five lead changes and four ties.
- Trailing 44-30 at the 14:18 mark of the second half, Vanderbilt went on a 19-6 run over 5:24 to pull within one at 50-49. The Commodores took their first lead of the second half, 57-56, with 4:17 left.
- Tennessee led by as much as 15 in the game, spurred by a 15-2 run that gave the Volunteers a 30-15 lead with 4:06 remaining in the first half.
- Vanderbilt's 22 points at halftime marked the fewest allowed by UT in a half this season.
- Points off turnovers were 17-5 in favor of the Vols.

Tennessee Notes:

- Tennessee improves to 15-18 and has won two straight games after a four-game skid.
- This marks the first time since 2010 that UT has won multiple games at the SEC Tournament.
- Detrick Mostella totaled his second-most points in a game this year with a game-high 18. He is averaging 17.5 points through the first two games of the SEC Tournament.
- Devon Baukman collected a career-high five steals.
- Armani Moore notched a pair of blocks to tie for seventh on the UT all-time list with 131.
- For the fourth time this year and sixth time in his career, Derek Reese grabbed double-digit rebounds with 10.

Vanderbilt Notes:

- Vanderbilt falls to 19-13 and has dropped two straight games after a four-game winning streak.
- Wade Baldwin IV posted team highs of 13 points and eight assists while adding six rebounds.
- Joe Toye posted a career-best four assists and matched his career highs with 10 points and four rebounds.
- Damian Jones reached double-digit points for the ninth straight game with 12.
