Quarterfinals Round – Game #9 Notes Georgia 65, South Carolina 64

Georgia advances to face Kentucky Saturday at approximately 2:30 p.m. CT

Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Georgia leads 58-50
- SEC Tournament: Georgia leads 3-0
- Season Series: Georgia leads 3-0
- Georgia has a four-game winning streak in the series.

Game Notes:

- With the Gamecocks ahead 59-52 with 5:17 remaining, the Bulldogs scored eight straight points to take their first lead of the game with 3:04 left. That was among five lead changes and four ties over the final three-plus minutes of the game.
- South Carolina did not trail during the first 36:54 of the game and led by as much as 11.
- Trailing 45-34 with 13:19 remaining in the game, Georgia went on a 13-2 run, including nine straight points, to tie the contest at 47-47 with 9:19 left.
- Fast break points were 11-2 in favor of the Bulldogs.
- The Gamecocks posted a 10-2 edge in steals.

Georgia Notes:

- Georgia improves to 19-12 and has won five straight games.
- The Bulldogs advance to the SEC Tournament semifinals for the third consecutive year.
- J.J. Frazier notched his 12th 20-point game of the year and fifth in the last seven with a team-high 21, including the game-winning free throw with 2.1 seconds left.
- Yante Maten notched his ninth double-double of the year and 10th of his career with 17 points and 12 rebounds.

South Carolina Notes:

- South Carolina falls to 24-8 and has dropped three of its last four games.
- Sindarius Thornwell registered his sixth 20-point performance of the year with a game-high 23.
- Laimonus Chatkevicius narrowly missed a double-double with 14 points and a team-high nine rebounds.
- Mindaugas Kacinas was credited with a season-high three steals.
