# Quarterfinals Round – Game #6 Notes Texas A&M 72, Florida 66

# Texas A&M advances to face Tennessee/LSU Saturday at noon CT

#### **Series Notes:**

All-Time Series: Florida leads 5-4SEC Tournament: First meeting

Season Series: Tied at 1-1

## **Game Notes:**

- There were 11 ties and seven lead changes. Neither team led by more than six points.
- Tied with 9:58 left in the game, the Aggies scored six straight points to match the largest lead of the game at 59-53. They never trailed again.
- Points in the paint were 44-30 in favor of Texas A&M.
- Florida enjoyed a 35-19 edge in bench points.
- The teams combined to shoot just 7-of-35 from the 3-point line (20.0 percent).

## Texas A&M Notes:

- Texas A&M improves to 25-7 and is riding a seven-game winning streak.
- The Aggies advance in the SEC Tournament for the first time since their inaugural season in the conference in 2013.
- For the third time this year and the first time since December 29, Tyler Davis topped the Aggies in scoring or tied for the lead with 15 points. He also grabbed a team-high eight rebounds.
- Daniel House also totaled 15 points.

## Florida Notes:

- Florida falls to 19-14 and has dropped five of its last seven games.
- The Gators fail to reach the SEC Tournament semifinals for the second straight season after four consecutive trips from 2011-14.
- For the second straight game and fifth time this year, Kasey Hill led the Gators in scoring with 18 points off the bench. After averaging 8.0 ppg in the regular season, Hill scored at an 18.0 clip in the SEC Tournament.
- Among five Gators in double figures, Dorian Finney-Smith reached double-digit points for the 18<sup>th</sup> time in his last 20 games with 11 while adding a game-high nine boards.
