#6 Texas A&M vs. #11 Florida

Tournament Notes

Following today's 67-48 victory, Texas A&M advances to the quarterfinal round of the SEC Tournament for the fifth time. The Aggies have made it to at least Friday every year since joining the conference in 2013.

With the victory today, Texas A&M has recorded its 12th straight 20+ win season. That is the second longest streak in the SEC, behind only Tennessee.

A&M improves to 6-3 in the SEC Tournament, improving its winning percentage to .666, which is the second best mark in the conference.

Today's game was the first matchup between Florida and Texas A&M in the SEC Tournament.

The 19 point margin of victory for Texas A&M is its second largest in the tournament. A&M defeated Auburn by 32 points (86-54) on March 7, 2014.

Today's session three attendance of 3,568 is the largest since 2012, when the tournament was hosted in Nashville, Tenn.

Khaalia Hillsman's 24 points are the third most by an Aggie in the SEC Tournament. She also posted 11 boards, which is the third best mark by an Aggie in the tournament as well.
