Second Round – Game #5 Notes Vanderbilt 66, Texas A&M 41 Vanderbilt advances to face Florida Friday at 6 p.m. CT

Game Notes:

- With the Aggies within five at the 17:27 mark of the second half, the Commodores reeled off an 8-0 run to take a 39-26 lead. A&M never got closer than nine the rest of the way.
- The VU bench outscored the A&M reserves 17-0.
- The Dores enjoyed a 14-6 edge in turnovers.

Vanderbilt Notes:

- Vanderbilt improves to 18-14 overall and 6-1 in its last seven games.
- The 25-point margin of victory is the Commodores' largest in SEC Tournament play.
- Joe Toye posted career highs of 18 points and five 3-pointers (5-of-8).
- Joe Roberson recorded double-digit rebounds for the sixth time this season with 10.
- Matthew Fisher-Davis connected on a pair of 3-pointers to move into a tie for eighth on the VU career list with 226 trevs.
- Riley La Chance drilled four 3s (4-of-8) and finished with 14 points.

Texas A&M Notes:

- Texas A&M falls to 16-15.
- The 41 points was a season low and the Aggies' fewest in an SEC Tournament game. It is tied for sixth lowest in SEC Tournament history (since 1979).
- Tyler Davis poured in a team-high 18 points.
- Robert Williams was one point shy of a double-double with nine points and a team-high 10 rebounds.
