Second Round – Game #6 Notes

Ole Miss 86, Missouri 74

Ole Miss advances to face Arkansas Friday at approximately 8:30 p.m. CT

Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Ole Miss leads 9-1
- SEC Tournament: Ole Miss leads 2-0
- Season Series: Ole Miss leads 3-0

Game Notes:

- With Mizzou trailing by only two late in the first half, Ole Miss used a 9-0 run to take a 39-28 lead with 2:41 until halftime. The Tigers did not get closer than nine the rest of the game.
- Ole Miss was 31-of-47 from the free throw line, while Mizzou was just 10-of-13. The 47 attempts is a season high for the Rebels.
- The teams combined for just 16 turnovers. The seven for Ole Miss is a season low.
- The Rebels outrebounded the Tigers 40-32.

Ole Miss Notes:

- Ole Miss improves to 20-12 overall and 4-1 in its last five games.
- The Rebels secure their third straight 20-win season and ninth in the last 11 seasons.
- Sebastian Saiz posted his SEC-leading 20th double-double of the year with 14 points and 16 rebounds. Saiz moved into second on the Rebel career rebounds list with 953.
- After missing the Rebels' last game, Deandre Burnett returned to action with a game-high 23 points for his 10th game of 20 or more points this year. He was perfect in the first half, shooting 6-for-6 from the field and 4-for-4 from the free throw line.

Missouri Notes:

- Missouri falls to 8-24 overall and 1-7 in its last eight games.
- Kevin Puryear followed up his 30-point outburst in the first round of the SEC Tournament with 15 against Ole Miss. He averaged 21.3 over the final three games of the season.
- Terrence Phillips posted a game-high eight assists with 15 points.
- Jordan Barnett grabbed a team-best six rebounds along with 15 points.
