Quarterfinals – Game #10 Notes

Arkansas 73, Ole Miss 72

Arkansas advances to face Vanderbilt Saturday at approximately 2:30 p.m. CT

Series Notes:

- All-Time Series: Arkansas leads 44-47
- SEC Tournament: First meeting
- Season Series: Arkansas leads 2-0

Game Notes:

- There were 13 ties and 12 lead changes, and no team led by more than nine.
- Points off turnovers were 22-6 in favor of Arkansas.
- The Rebels outrebounded the Razorbacks 50-39.

Arkansas Notes:

- Arkansas improves to 24-8 overall and 7-1 in its last eight games.
- The Razorbacks advance to the SEC Tournament semifinals for the 13th time and first since 2015.
- Daryl Macon led the team with 17 points and connected on 9-of-10 free throws.
- Jaylen Barford posted 13 points and four assists and matched his career high for rebounds with six.
- Dusty Hannahs added 13 points.

Ole Miss Notes:

- Ole Miss falls to 20-13 and loses for just the second time in its last six games.
- Terence Davis notched his fifth game of 20 or more points this season with a game-high 26 along with nine rebounds. He equaled his career high for assists with four. Davis averaged 22.5 points in two tournament games.
- Sebastian Saiz totaled 17 rebounds and averaged 16.5 boards in the tourney. He failed to score double-digit points for just the fifth time this season with nine.
- Deandre Burnett added 16 points.
- The Rebels' 47 field goal attempts is a season high.
