



2018 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament

#13 Arkansas vs. #5 Texas A&M

ARKANSAS NOTES

- The Razorbacks are now 13-18 overall, 12-27 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- Arkansas finished with five turnovers, the 11th time this season the Razorbacks finished with single-digit turnovers.
- UA dominated the turnover battle, 18-5 and turned the 18 Texas A&M miscues into 16 points.
- The third-leading 3-point shooting team in the SEC, Arkansas hit only six shots from beyond the arc, below the season average of 7.6.
- Graduate guard Devin Cosper scored 15 points to lead the Razorbacks, scoring in double figures for the 21st time in 2017-18.
- Junior guard Malica Monk added 13 points, her 29th game in double figures this season.

TEXAS A&M NOTES

- Texas A&M improved to 23-8 on the season and 8-4 all-time in the SEC Tournament.
- Senior Khaalia Hillsman posted a season high in rebounds with 13 topping her previous best of 11 boards which she last recorded against Tennessee. Hillsman pitched in 10 points on the offensive end for her 23rd career double-double
- The Aggies corralled a season-high with 63 boards while limiting the Razorbacks to just 29. The 63 rebounds were the most by any team in an SEC-on-SEC game this season and three shy of the SEC Tournament record of 66 set by Mississippi State in 1982.
- SEC Freshman of the Year Chennedy Carter dropped 19 points for her 30th double-figure scoring game in her 31 career appearances. Carter also chipped in a game-high eight assists.
- Texas A&M moved to 12-1 in their opening-round game at the conference tournament since 2006.
- Junior Danni Williams scored a game-high 22 points hitting 4-of-5 from behind the arc. Williams was one of 11 Aggies to make it into the scoring column in the contest.
- After starting the game 1-of-5 from the field, the Aggies hit their next 12 shots over a stretch of 8+ minutes.
- The A&M defense held the Razorbacks to 24.7 percent shooting on the game, the lowest by an Aggie opponent this season by over five percent.
- Junior Anriel Howard finished with 13 rebounds in the game with a dozen boards coming in the second half.
