

2018 SEC Men's Basketball Tournament

Second Round – Game #6 Notes
Arkansas 69, South Carolina 64
Arkansas advances to face Florida Friday at approximately 8:30 p.m. CT

Series Notes:

All-Time Series: Arkansas 20-13
 SEC Tournament: Arkansas leads 3-2
 Season Series: Arkansas leads 2-0

The Razorbacks have five of the last six meetings, including the last three.

Game Notes:

- South Carolina scored the game's first basket and never led again.
- From the 1:52 mark of the first half to the 16:18 mark of the second, Arkansas went on a 17-4 run to earn its biggest lead of the game, 47-32.
- The Gamecocks pulled within one point at 56-55 with 7:22 remaining after a 16-4 run but could get no closer.
- Arkansas shot a season-best 88.5 percent (23-of-26) from the free throw line.
- The Razorbacks enjoyed a 10-2 edge in steals.
- The Gamecocks outrebounded the Hogs 42-29.

Arkansas Notes:

- Arkansas improves 22-10 and wins for the seventh time in the last nine games.
- The Razorbacks will play in the SEC Tournament quarterfinals for the third time in the last four years.
- Jaylen Barford led all scorers with 17 points to go with three steals.
- Daryl Macon connected on all eight of this free throw attempts, including two key ones in the final 40 seconds. He finished with 12 points, four assists and four rebounds.

South Carolina Notes:

- South Carolina falls to 17-16.
- With 15 points and 11 rebounds, Chris Silva posted his 10th double-double of the year and 15th of his career. He averaged 18.0 points and 11.0 boards in the two SEC Tournament games.
- Maik Kotsar finished one shy of his career high in points with 15 to go with seven rebounds.
