



## **2018 SEC Men's Basketball Tournament**

**St. Louis, Mo. – Scottrade Center**

**Quarterfinals – Game #10 Notes**

**Arkansas 80, Florida 72**

**Arkansas advances to face Tennessee in the semifinals Saturday at approximately 2:30 p.m. CT**

### **Series Notes:**

- All-Time Series: Florida leads 23-12
- SEC Tournament: Florida leads 4-2
- Season Series: Tied at 1-1
- The Razorbacks snap a four-game skid against the Gators in SEC Tournament play.

### **Game Notes:**

- Arkansas scored the final eight points of the first half to take its first lead of the game going into halftime, 30-29. The Razorbacks have won 40 consecutive games when leading at the break.
- After six lead changes in the first three minutes of the second half, the Razorbacks reeled off a 7-0 run to take a 42-37 advantage at the 16:28 mark. Arkansas later used a 12-0 run to take its largest lead of 14 at 62-48 with 5:58 left in the game.
- The Razorbacks outrebounded the Gators 43-28.
- Arkansas enjoyed a 30-20 edge in points in the paint.
- The Razorbacks shot 53.6 percent in the second half, compared to the Gators at 40.0 percent.
- Florida reserves outscored the Arkansas bench 27-12.
- There were only three total free throws in the first half and no makes (Florida 0-2, Arkansas 0-1)

### **Arkansas Notes:**

- Arkansas improves to 23-10 and is victorious for the eighth time in the last 10 games.
- The Razorbacks advance to the SEC Tournament semifinals for the third time in the last four years.
- Jaylen Barford recorded his second career double-double with 27 points, which is one shy of his career high, and 10 rebounds. It marked his 18<sup>th</sup> career 20-point game and 11<sup>th</sup> away from Bud Walton Arena.
- Daniel Gafford notched his third career double-double with 16 points and 12 rebounds, which matches his career high.

### **Florida Notes:**

- Florida falls to 20-12 and ends its three-game win streak.
- On 8-of-10 shooting including 4-for-5 3-pointers, Keith Stone posted his third career 20-point game with a team-high 22, which is one shy of his career high.
- Chris Chiozza scored his most points in 11 games with 16 to go with a game-high six assists.
