MISSOURI POST-GAME NOTES

- The matchup with South Carolina marked Missouri's fifth time in the SEC Tournament. The
 Tigers have made the tournament in five of their six years since joining the Southeastern
 Conference with their only absence coming in 2014.
- Missouri is now 2-7 in the SEC Tournament following tonight's loss to SC.
- The contest between the Tigers and Gamecocks was the 21st in series history between the two
 programs. South Carolina holds the all-time advantage, 14-7. In SEC Tournament pairings, the
 win by the Gamecocks gives them a slight 2-1 advantage.
- Andy Toelken suffered his first loss in relief this season across 16 total appearances out of the bullpen. He is now 4-1 with three saves in 33.2 innings pitched as a reliever. The senior has also combined for 31 strikeouts during that stretch.
- The Tigers' 1-through-3 hitters contributed three of Missouri's four hits and both of MU's runs on the night.
- Trey Harris' single in the fourth inning extended his hitting streak to five games as he finished his night at 1-for-4. In that stretch, the senior is batting .450 (9-20) with a double and a triple, two home runs and one walk and has totaled multiple hits in the first four games of the streak. He has also added five RBI and seven runs scored during the five games.

MISSOURI COACH STEVE BIESER

Opening statement . . .

"It was tough for us to get anything going consistently offensively. We had that one inning where we punched a couple of runs across the boards. Our pitchers battled, and our defense was right there with it. It was a really tight ballgame tonight, and we just couldn't find enough opportunities to score some runs. We had a plan against their starter, and we weren't executing early. In the inning that we did, we were able to scratch a few runs across and knock him out, but then their bullpen came in and did an outstanding job."
