TEXAS A&M POST-GAME NOTES

- With the loss to Ole Miss, Texas A&M falls to 11-7 all-time in SEC Tournament games.
- The Aggies' series advantage over the Rebels was trimmed to 13-12 following the loss. The two teams are now even at one-game apiece in SEC Tournament pairings.
- All four games this season between Texas A&M and Ole Miss have been decided by one run with the Rebels holding a 3-1 advantage in the four matchups.
- With today's loss, Texas A&M was eliminated from the 2018 SEC Tournament, finishing 3-1 in four games in Hoover.
- Cason Sherrrod's relief outing in today's game was the 74th of his career at Texas A&M, tying him with Brian Parker (1992-95) for the 10th all-time on the A&M appearances list.
- Michael Helman's single in the first inning extended his hitting streak to eight games.
- Helman finished his day 2-for-4 for his team-leading 27th multi-hit game of the season.
- Logan Foster went 2-for-4 on the day with his second triple of the tournament to lead all hitters.

TEXAS A&M COACH ROB CHILDRESS

Opening Statement . . .

"I couldn't be more proud of our team with the way we performed all week and the way we competed. Mitchell Kilkeny gave us a great start, and we played flawless defense behind him. Our bullpen did a nice job as well. We had a few opportunities offensively to get some big hits, and we weren't able to make that happen. It is funny, baseball is a game where you can score runs and make hits maybe six inches over the top of our third baseman's glove. They go second and third and cash in. It's the way our series went in College Station. It was very close, and Ole Miss is a very talented team. You can't come up for errors against their offense. They are incredibly well coached, as well."

On learning about the team . . .

"I think we found out who are supposed to be and how we are supposed to go about our business in games of this magnitude. The guys emptied it out for each other for the entire week. When you can see that, feel that, and know what it takes, it's incredible. That's what it takes to play at an incredibly high level against some incredibly talented teams."

On heading post season . . .

"That's the way you want to feel during this time of the year. You want to feel like you played the best and that you are as cohesive as you can possibly be. I feel like we are."

On Jordan Fowler keeping the A&M batting off balance . . .

"He was definitely mixing in three pitches for strikes. We got a little better on our approach during the game. We just need to get back on top of that moving on into later parts of the game. We had that energy toward the end but it just wasn't enough."
