ARKANSAS POST-GAME NOTES

- Arkansas' loss in tonight's game moved its all-time SEC Tournament record to 33-40 overall. The Razorbacks finished 2-1 in the 2018 installment.
- The Razorbacks finished 1-3 against LSU this season, following tonight's game.
- Isaiah Campbell's 86 pitches were his most in a start since March 17 in game one of the doubleheader with Kentucky. In that start against the Wildcats, Campbell tossed 108 pitches.
- Jake Reindl's relief outing was his 21st of the season to tie him with Barrett Loseke for the team lead in appearances.
- Jared Gates' home run was Arkansas' sixth of the tournament, a total that leads all teams.
- Gates finished with two of the Hogs' three hits on Saturday evening.
- The three hits by the Razorbacks were their fewest against an SEC opponent this season and tied for the lowest in any game in 2018. The Razorbacks also had three hits on Feb. 24 at San Diego State.
- Luke Bonfield's hitting streak ended at eight games. During that time, the senior batted .407 (11-27) with a double, a pair of home runs and seven walks. He added seven RBI, nine runs scored and one stolen base during the streak.
- Bonfield's walk extended his reached base streak to 16 consecutive games.
