- SEC Player of the Week – Alabama guard Jaden Shackelford, a 6-foot-3, 200-pound sophomore from Hesperia, Calif., had 26 points four rebounds, two assists and a block in the Crimson Tide's win over ETSU. Shackelford shot 53.3 percent (8-of-15) from the field, including 61.5 percent (8-of-13) from 3-point range.
- SEC Freshman of the Week – LSU guard Cam Thomas, a 6-foot-4, 210-pound freshman from Chesapeake, Va., scored 29 points to go with three rebounds, two assists and a block in a win over Nicholls St. He converted 47.6 percent (10-of-21) of this field goals in the game. It was his fourth game with 20 or more points and the third time he made 10 field goals.
- This week marks the start of the 89th season of Southeastern Conference men's basketball action.
- Five teams are receiving mention in the December 28 Associated Press Top 25 highlighted by Tennessee (7th) and Missouri (12th). Arkansas, Florida and Georgia are receiving votes.
- Mississippi State head coach Ben Howland registered his 500th career win on Nov. 30 against Texas State.
- Tennessee was the favorite to win the 2021 SEC championship in a preseason poll of media from around the league and nation. Kentucky was picked to finish second and is followed by LSU, Florida and Alabama. Florida's Keyontae Johnson was selected by the media as the pre-season player of the year.
- Seventy-seven players from SEC schools were on 2020-21 NBA Opening Day rosters. All 14 SEC schools were represented and at least one SEC player is on 28 of 30 NBA rosters.
- For the second year in a row, 12 SEC players

- were picked in the 2020 NBA Draft, including six who were chosen in the first round.
- Georgia's Anthony Edwards became the fifth SEC player to be picked first overall in the NBA Draft in the last 11 years.
- The 2020 NBA Draft marked the fourth time (1988, 2015 and 2018) that the SEC had four lottery picks in a single NBA Draft.
- Nine former SEC players from six different schools were on the rosters of the Los Angeles Lakers and Miami Heat in the 2020 NBA Finals. That was more than double the total of any other conference.
- Five of the 10 players named to the 2020 NBA All-Defensive teams were from SEC schools.
- The SEC's 15 NCAA Tournament selections since 2018 are second-most in the nation.
- Eleven SEC coaches have taken their teams to the Sweet 16, nine have advanced to the Elite Eight and six have gone on to the Final Four.

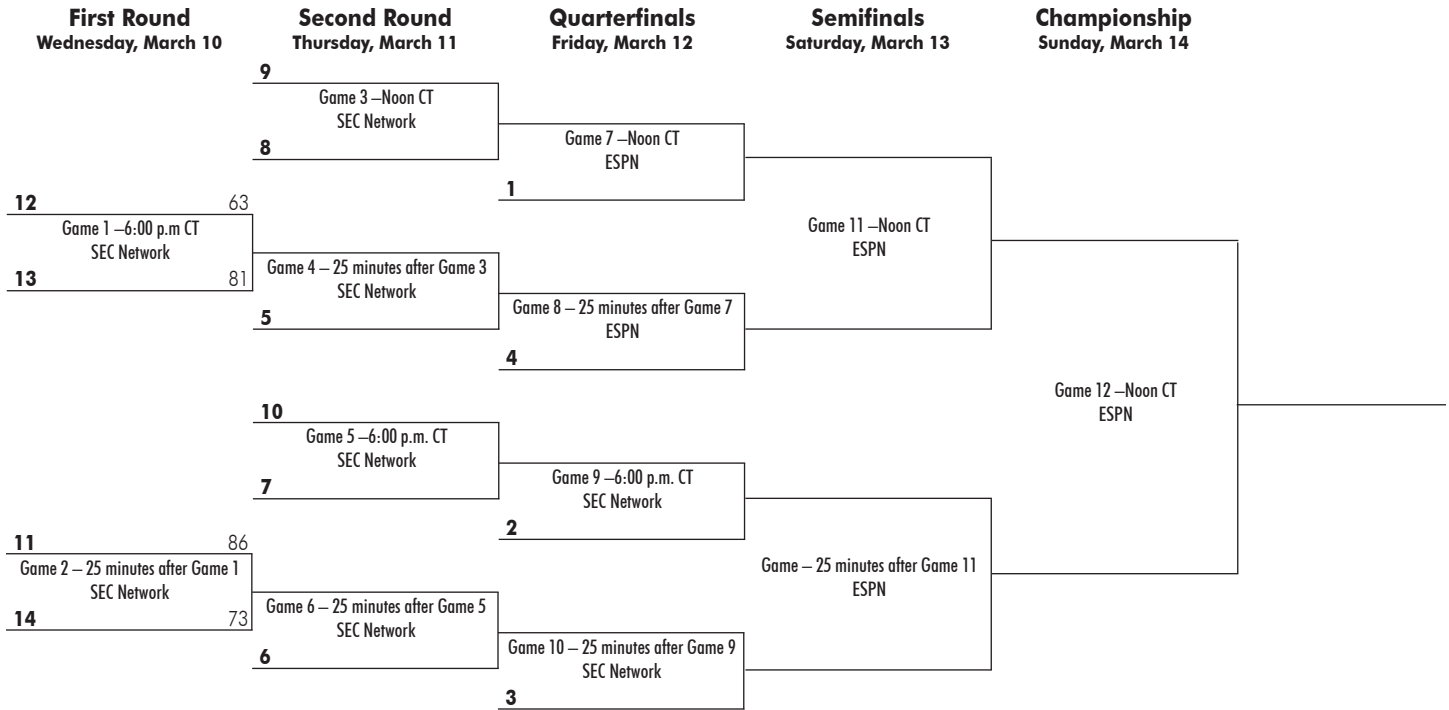

2021 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BRIDGESTONE ARENA • NASHVILLE, TENN.



The winner of the 13-game SEC Men’s Basketball Tournament receives the league’s automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-14 based on their regular season conference finish.

Atlanta served as host of the inaugural SEC Tournament played following the 1932-33 season and did so again after the 1933-34 season. The event was held every year through 1952, with the exception of 1935. After a 26-year layoff (1953-78), the tournament was renewed in 1979. The 2020 tournament will be the 61st in league history and the 42nd since the renewal.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 26 of the tournament champions since the tournament resumed in 1979 have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Twenty of those teams have gone on to the Elite Eight, 12 to the Final Four and three have been crowned national champion. Six of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have advanced to the Final Four with three of those teams winning a national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only four times.

Kentucky leads the league with 31 SEC Tournament titles. Alabama is second with six, while Tennessee and Florida are tied for third with four. Mississippi State has three championship trophies while Auburn, Georgia, Ole Miss and Vanderbilt have two. Arkansas, LSU and former league member Georgia Tech have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC Tournament Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Men’s Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings.

- Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
 - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner.
- Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
 - Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
 - If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
 - If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Thirteen of the 14 SEC coaches have led their teams to the NCAA Tournament. The one not included in that list just completed his first season coaching collegiately and was previously named NBA G League Coach of the Year.
- Eleven SEC coaches have taken their teams to the Sweet 16, nine have advanced to the Elite Eight and six have gone on to the Final Four.
- Six SEC coaches - Bruce Pearl, Tom Crean, John Calipari, Ben Howland, Frank Martin and Rick Barnes - have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- The coaches have combined for 220 seasons of head coaching experience, more than 4,800 career wins, 55 conference titles and 117 NCAA Tournament appearances.

The Nation's Best Players

- 77 players from SEC schools were on 2020-21 NBA Opening Day rosters. All 14 SEC schools were represented and at least one SEC player was on 28 of 30 NBA rosters.
- Twelve SEC players were picked at the 2020 NBA Draft, including six who were chosen in the first round. It is the second year in a row a dozen SEC players were selected, including six in the first round.
- The 2020 NBA Draft marked the fourth time (1988, 2015 and 2018) that the SEC had four lottery picks in a single NBA Draft.
- The SEC has had at least five first round NBA Draft picks in five of the last six years (2015-20).
- Georgia's Anthony Edwards was drafted No. 1 overall in the 2020 NBA Draft. He is the sixth SEC player to be picked first overall in the draft and the fifth in the last 11 years (2010-20).
- The SEC's 30 Lottery Picks since 2010 are the second-most of any conference.
- Over the last 11 NBA Drafts (2010-20), 88 SEC players have heard their names called. Fifty-one of those were selected in the first round and five were the No. 1 overall pick.
- Nine former SEC players from six different schools were on the rosters of the Los Angeles Lakers and Miami Heat in the 2020 NBA Finals. That was more than double the total of any other conference.
- Five of the 10 players named to the 2020 NBA All-Defensive teams were from SEC schools.

Postseason Success

- The SEC's 15 NCAA Tournament selections since 2018 are second-most in the nation.
- The SEC's eight NCAA Tournament selections in 2018 are the most in league history.
- The SEC's 10 teams advancing to postseason play in 2018 (8 NCAA, 2 NIT) ties for the most in league history. In 2001, six SEC teams received NCAA Tournament invites while four participated in the NIT.
- SEC teams are 67-36 (64.1 percent) in the NCAA Tournament since 2012.
- SEC teams are 37-12 (75.5 percent) in postseason opening games since 2014.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in 29 of the last 30 tournaments. All of the SEC's 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16 since 1996.
- The SEC has had a team in the Final Four in six of the last nine tournaments.
- Eight different SEC teams (Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State and South Carolina) have appeared in the Final Four.
- Every team in the SEC has made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last five editions of the NCAA Tournament.

Academics

- LSU's Skylar Mays was named the 2020 CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year. He was a two-time first team CoSIDA Academic All-America (2019 and 2020).
- A total of 99 men's basketball students were named to the 2019-20 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- 461 men's basketball students have been named to the SEC's Academic Honor Rolls over the last six years.
