Conference Notes

- The SEC has advanced at least one team to the Elite Eight in nine of the last 11 tournaments.
- Nine different SEC teams have advanced to the Sweet 16 in the last four NCAA Tournaments.
- The SEC has had at least one team in the Sweet 16 in 30 of the last 31 NCAA Tournaments.
- The SEC advanced at least four teams into the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the fourth straight tournament.
- The SEC has had 21 NCAA Tournament selections over the last three tournaments Only the ACC (23) has had more.
- SEC teams are 73-43 (62.9 percent) in the NCAA Tournament since 2012 (10-3 in 2012, 4-3 in 2013, 12-3 in 2014, 6-5 in 2015, 3-3 in 2016, 11-5 in 2017, 8-8 in 2018, 12-7 in 2019 and 7-6 in 2021).
- SEC teams are 42-15 (73.7 percent) in postseason opening games over the last seven tournaments (7-0 in 2014, 6-2 in 2015, 5-2 in 2016, 5-3 in 2017, 7-2 in 2018, 6-3 in 2019 and 5-3 in 2021).
- Every SEC team has made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last six tournaments.
- The SEC has advanced a team in the Final Four six of the last nine tournaments.
- Eight different SEC teams (Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State and South Carolina) have appeared in the Final Four.
- Four SEC schools in the Top 30 of the NCAA's NET were third-most among all conferences.
- The SEC's 101 Quadrant 1 and Quadrant 2 wins ranked second among all conferences.
- All 14 SEC schools played schedules that ranked among the Top 90 SOS in the NCAA's NET, 11 ranked in the Top 50.
- Six teams rank among the Top 40 defensive teams in the nation according to KenPom.com.

- The SEC played 93 percent of its scheduled league games this season (116 of 126 regular season and 12 of 12 tournament).
- Alabama clinched its eighth SEC regular season championship with a 16-2 league record. It is the Crimson Tide's first SEC title since 2002.
- Alabama won its seventh SEC Tournament championship and first since 1991.
- The SEC won the eighth annual SEC/Big 12 Challenge by winning five of the nine games on January 30. The SEC has a 25-24 lead in the event over the last five years.

Team/Individual Notes

- Alabama made its 21st NCAA Tournament appearance and first since 2018. The Crimson Tide's No. 2 seed ties the 1987 and 2002 teams for highest seeding in school history.
- Third-seeded Arkansas made its first appearance in the Elite Eight since 1995.
- Florida earned a trip to the NAAs for the fourth straight tournament and 21st time overall.
- LSU earned a berth into the NCAA Tournament for the 23rd time in school history and the second straight tournament.
- Ole Miss received a No. 1 seed in the NIT and made its 13th appearance in the tournament.
- Mississippi State advanced to the NIT championship game for the first time in school history.
- Missouri played in the NCAA Tournament for second time in the last three times possible and the 28th time in school history.
- Tennessee made its third straight NCAA Tournament appearance. This was Tennessee's 23rd all-time NCAA Tournament appearance.

The winner of the 13-game SEC Men's Basketball Tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-14 based on their regular season conference finish.

Atlanta served as host of the inaugural SEC Tournament played following the 1932-33 season and did so again after the 1933-34 season. The event was held every year through 1952, with the exception of 1935. After a 26-year layoff (1953-78), the tournament was renewed in 1979. The 2020 tournament will be the 61st in league history and the 42nd since the renewal.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 26 of the tournament champions since the tournament resumed in 1979 have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Twenty of those teams have gone on to the Elite Eight, 12 to the Final Four and three have been crowned national champion. Six of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have advanced to the Final Four with three of those teams winning a national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only four times.

Kentucky leads the league with 31 SEC Tournament titles. Alabama is second with six, while Tennessee and Florida are tied for third with four. Mississippi State has three championship trophies while Auburn, Georgia, Ole Miss and Vanderbilt have two. Arkansas, LSU and former league member Georgia Tech have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Thirteen of the 14 SEC coaches have led their teams to the NCAA Tournament. The one not included in that list just completed his first season coaching collegiately and was previously named NBA G League Coach of the Year.
- Twelve SEC coaches have taken their teams to the Sweet 16, 10 have advanced to the Elite Eight and six have gone on to the Final Four.
- Six SEC coaches - Bruce Pearl, Tom Crean, John Calipari, Ben Howland, Frank Martin and Rick Barnes - have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- The coaches have combined for 234 seasons of head coaching experience, more than 5,000 career wins, 56 conference titles and 123 NCAA Tournament appearances.

The Nation's Best Players

- 77 players from SEC schools were on 2020-21 NBA Opening Day rosters. All 14 SEC schools were represented and at least one SEC player was on 28 of 30 NBA rosters.
- Twelve SEC players were picked at the 2020 NBA Draft, including six who were chosen in the first round. It is the second year in a row a dozen SEC players were selected, including six in the first round.
- Of the 24 SEC players picked in the NBA Draft over the last two years, 21 had at least one year of eligibility remaining. All 12 first round selections had at least one year of eligibility remaining.
- The 2020 NBA Draft marked the fourth time (1988, 2015 and 2018) that the SEC had four lottery picks in a single NBA Draft.
- The SEC has had at least five first round NBA Draft picks in five of the last six years (2015-20).
- Georgia's Anthony Edwards was drafted No. 1 overall in the 2020 NBA Draft. He is the sixth SEC player to be picked first overall in the draft and the fifth in the last 11 years (2010-20).
- The SEC's 30 Lottery Picks since 2010 are the second-most of any conference.
- Over the last 11 NBA Drafts (2010-20), 88 SEC players have heard their names called. Fifty-one of those were selected in the first round and five were the No. 1 overall pick.
- Five former SEC players were named 2021 NBA All-Stars. Washington's Bradley Beal (UF) was named a starter while the Los Angeles Lakers' Anthony Davis (UK), New York's Julius Randle (UK) and Philadelphia's Ben Simmons (LS) were named reserves. Phoenix's Devin Booker was added to the roster by Adam Silver.
- Nine former SEC players from six different schools were on the rosters of the Los Angeles Lakers and Miami Heat in the 2020 NBA Finals. That was more than double the total of any other conference.
- Five of the 10 players named to the 2020 NBA All-Defensive teams were from SEC schools.

Postseason Success

- The SEC's 21 NCAA Tournament selections since 2018 are tied for second-most in the nation.
- The SEC's eight NCAA Tournament selections in 2018 are the most in league history.
- The SEC's 10 teams advancing to postseason play in 2018 (8 NCAA, 2 NIT) ties for the most in league history. In 2001, six SEC teams received NCAA Tournament invites while four participated in the NIT.
- SEC teams are 73-43 (62.9 percent) in the NCAA Tournament since 2012.
- SEC teams are 42-15 (73.7 percent) in postseason opening games since 2014.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in 30 of the last 31 tournaments. All of the SEC's 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16 since 1996.
- The SEC has had a team in the Final Four in six of the last 10 tournaments.
- Eight different SEC teams (Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State and South Carolina) have appeared in the Final Four.
- Every team in the SEC has made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last five editions of the NCAA Tournament.

Academics

- LSU's Skylar Mays was named the 2020 CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year. He was a two-time first team CoSIDA Academic All-America (2019 and 2020).
- A total of 99 men's basketball students were named to the 2019-20 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- 461 men's basketball students have been named to the SEC's Academic Honor Rolls over the last six years.
