• SEC Player of the Week – Mississippi State forward Jimmy Bell Jr., a 6-foot-10, 280-pound graduate senior from Saginaw, Mich., had 17 points, 18 rebounds and three blocks in leading the Bulldogs to a win over Rutgers in the Gotham Classic. Bell earned Gotham Classic Game MVP honors after shooting 6-of-11 from the field and 5-of-6 from the free throw line. The 17 points were a season-high while the 18 rebounds were a career mark.

• SEC Freshman of the Week – Kentucky guard Reed Sheppard, a 6-foot-3, 187-pound freshman from London, Ky., notched his first double-double of his career with 11 points and 11 assists in UK's win at Louisville. The 11 assists are the most ever for a Wildcat against Louisville. He also had two steals, extending his streak of at least two steals in every game this season.

• Three SEC teams are ranked in the December 25 Associated Press poll. Tennessee leads the way at 6th, Kentucky is 8th, and Ole Miss is 24th. Additionally, Auburn, Texas A&M, South Carolina, Mississippi State, and Alabama are among the teams receiving votes.

• The SEC's five Top 25 NET teams are tied for most in the nation and eight Top 50 NET teams are second-most in the nation (as of Dec. 31).

• The SEC leads the nation 34 Quad 1 & 2 wins through games of Dec. 30.

• Ole Miss guard Matthew Murrell's 10 steals against Troy (12/19/23) tied the SEC single-game record set by Alabama's Anthony Murray (1978) and LSU's Shawn Griggs (1991).

• Former Missouri forward Kobe Brown has been honored as a recipient of the NCAA Today's Top 10 award and will be honored at the NCAA Convention in January. The award recog-

nizes former student-athletes for their exceptional athletic and academic achievements, as well as their contributions to their campuses and communities. The SEC led the nation with four honorees, also including Callie Dickinson of Georgia swimming & diving, Ashley Rogers of Tennessee softball and Trinity Thomas of Florida gymnastics.

• The SEC won the final three games of the first ACC/SEC Challenge to take a 7-7 tie with the ACC. The ACC/SEC Challenge marks the third interconference challenge the SEC has been a part of. The SEC also had events against the Big East (2007-08 to 2012-13) and Big 12 (2013-14 to 2022-23).

• Three SEC teams won holiday tournament titles this season: Auburn (Legends Classic), Mississippi State (Basketball Hall of Fame Tip-Off), South Carolina (Arizona Tip-Off).

• Seven SEC players have been named to the Naismith Player of the Year Watchlist: Trevon Brazile (Arkansas), Johni Broome (Auburn), Justin Edwards (Kentucky), Grant Nelson (Alabama), Tolu Smith III (Mississippi State), Wade Taylor IV (Texas A&M), and Santiago Vescovi (Tennessee).

• Tennessee is the favorite to win the 2024 SEC championship in a preseason poll of media from around the league and nation. Texas A&M was picked to finish second and is followed by Arkansas, Kentucky and Alabama. Texas A&M's Wade Taylor IV was selected by the media as the pre-season player of the year.

• 92 players from SEC schools were on 2023-24 NBA Opening Day rosters. Twelve of 14 SEC schools are represented and at least one SEC player is on 29 of the 30 NBA rosters.

The Coaches All-SEC team with individual awards will be released on Tuesday, March 7. This year's awards include: First and Second All-SEC Teams, All-Freshman Team, All-Defensive Team, Coach of the Year, Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Scholar-Athlete of the Year, Sixth Man of the Year and Freshman of the Year.

SEC SUCCESS**Individual Success**

- In 2023, Alabama's Brandon Miller earned the SEC's second straight National Freshman of the Year (Auburn's Jabari Smith in 2022).
- Three players earned All-America honors from the Associated Press in 2023: Alabama's Brandon Miller (1st team), Kentucky's Oscar Tshiebwe (2nd team) and Texas A&M's Wade Taylor IV (honorable mention).
- 92 players from SEC schools were on 2023-24 NBA Opening Day rosters. Twelve of 14 SEC schools are represented and at least one SEC player is on 29 of the 30 NBA rosters.
- 13 SEC players on 2023-24 NBA Opening Day rosters have made an NBA All-Star Game.
- The SEC led all conferences with 10 players selected in the 2023 NBA Draft. Six first round selections also led the nation.
- The first two college players selected in the 2023 NBA Draft - Alabama's Brandon Miller (2nd overall) and Arkansas' Anthony Black (6th overall) - were from the SEC.
- 60 SEC players have been selected in the last six NBA Drafts. That leads all conferences: 50 ACC, 41 Big Ten, 37 Pac-12, 29 Big 12 and 19 Big East.
- 34 SEC players have been selected in the first round of the last six NBA Drafts. That leads the nation: ACC 31, Pac-12 19, Big 12 16 and Big Ten 16.
- 18 NBA Draft Lottery picks in the last six years are the most in the nation. That leads the nation: ACC 14, Big 12 10, Big Ten nine, Pac-12 six.
- Six No. 1 overall NBA Draft picks since 2010.

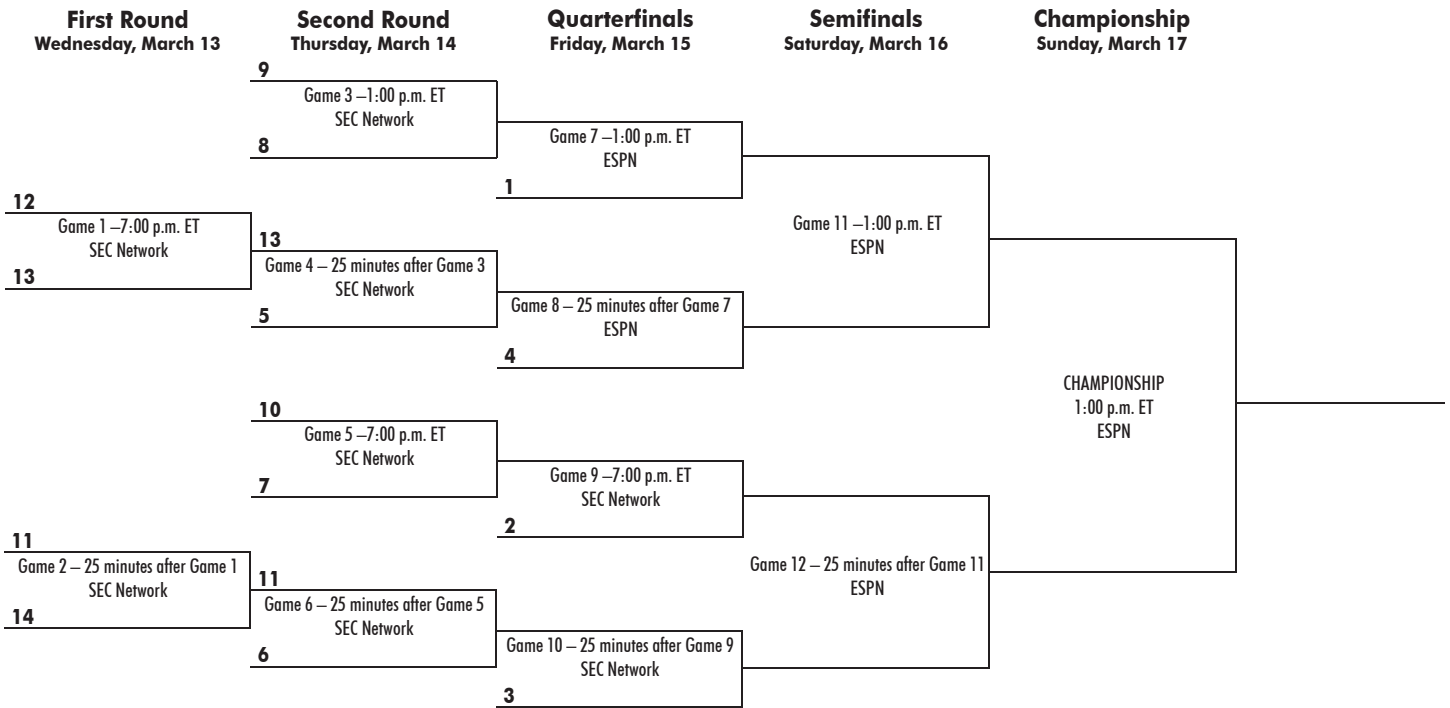
Team Success

- 35 NCAA Tournament selections over the last four tournaments.
- A record-tying 10 SEC teams received postseason bids in 2023. The SEC's eight NCAA Tournament selections tied its previous best set in 2018. Additionally, two SEC teams competed in the National Invitation Tournament.
- 14 of 14 SEC teams have made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last eight tournaments.
- Nine different SEC teams have advanced to the Sweet 16 in the last six NCAA Tournaments. All 14 SEC members have advanced to the Sweet 16 since 1996.
- The SEC has advanced at least one team to the Elite Eight in nine of the last 13 tournaments.
- The SEC has advanced a team in the Final Four six of the last 12 tournaments.
- Eight different SEC teams (Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State and South Carolina) have appeared in the Final Four.
- Since the 2018-19 season, four different SEC schools have been ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press Poll: Alabama 2023, Auburn 2022, Kentucky 2020, and Tennessee 2019.
- Eight different SEC schools have been ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press Poll: Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Kentucky, Missouri, South Carolina and Tennessee.

Fan Support

- The SEC ranked second nationally with 2,756,659 fans attending games during the 2022-23 season. An average of 11,344 fans attended games at SEC schools in 2023, an increase of 787 from 2022.
- Three of the top four attendance leaders in 2022-23 were from the SEC. Kentucky led the nation with a total attendance of 357,721 (19,873 average), Arkansas ranked with 323,875 fans (19,051 average) and Tennessee was fourth with 300,496 fans (18,781 average).

2023 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BRIDGESTONE ARENA • NASHVILLE, TN



The winner of the 13-game SEC Men’s Basketball Tournament receives the league’s automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-14 based on their regular season conference finish.

Atlanta served as host of the inaugural SEC Tournament played following the 1932-33 season and did so again after the 1933-34 season. The event was held every year through 1952, with the exception of 1935. After a 26-year layoff (1953-78), the tournament was renewed in 1979. The 2020 tournament will be the 61st in league history and the 42nd since the renewal.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 27 of the tournament champions since the tournament resumed in 1979 have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Twenty of those teams have gone on to the Elite Eight, 12 to the Final Four and three have been crowned national champion. Six of the last 15 SEC Tournament champions have advanced to the Final Four with three of those teams winning a national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only four times.

Kentucky leads the league with 31 SEC Tournament titles. Alabama is second with seven, while Tennessee and Florida are tied for third with four. Mississippi State has three championship trophies while Auburn, Georgia, Ole Miss and Vanderbilt have two. Arkansas, LSU and former league member Georgia Tech have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC Tournament Tie-Breaker Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Men’s Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes in the SEC Men’s Basketball Tournament.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** When three or more teams are tied, the following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken. If two teams remain tied after a tiebreaker provision, the two-team tiebreaker formula will be used.

- A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
- D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.
