• **Co-Players of the Week:** Ole Miss' Angel Baker scored a season-high 24 points coming off the bench against Texas Tech, which tied the most points scored by a Rebel in a game this season. She was the second leading scorer for Ole Miss in the 61-53 victory against No. 18 South Florida. It was the Rebels first win against a ranked non-conference opponent since 2007. On the week, she went 16-of-26 (.615), scoring 14.5 ppg with 2.5 rpg and 1.5 spg.

South Carolina's Destanni Henderson returned to the court after missing the last three games with a left leg injury and played 31 minutes. She pulled the team together in the second half after trailing by as many as 18 in the first to launch the biggest comeback in program history. Henderson led the team to out-score Stanford 22-7 in the third quarter, swiping five of her career-high seven steals in the period and dishing out four of her seven assists in that 10 minutes as well to give Gamecocks the lead. She added seven of her 17 points in the fourth quarter, including scoring each time Stanford took the lead in the period. Committed just two turnovers in 31 minutes on the court.

• **Freshman of the Week:** Georgia's Jillian Hollingshead posted the first double-figure scoring game of her career with 12 points in 15 minutes of action against South Alabama. Hollingshead was perfect on the day, knocking in 4-for-4 from the field and 4-for-4 from the free-throw line. The Powder Springs, Ga., native scored eight of her 12 points in the fourth quarter as she went a perfect 3-for-3 from the floor in the final 10 minutes. Her performance helped Georgia secure an 11-1 record in non-conference action and gave the team its 19th win in the last 23 contests dating back to last year.

### Notes:

- LSU's Khayla Pointer hit her 1,500th career point during the win over Texas Tech, becoming the 15th Tiger all-time to do so.
- Tennessee's Tamari Key recorded two blocks against Chattanooga, moving her career total to 201 to pass Ashley Robinson to settle into fourth place in all-time career blocks at UT.
- Ole Miss was named ESPN Team of the Week after wins at the West Palm Beach Invitational.
- Mizzou's Robin Pingeton hit the 200 win mark as a Tiger.
- Three women's basketball players will proudly add the

SEC grad patch to their uniforms after earning their degrees in December: Megan Abrams, Alabama; LaDazhia Williams, Missouri; Jordan Nixon, Texas A&M. They join the previous 30 listed on page 4.

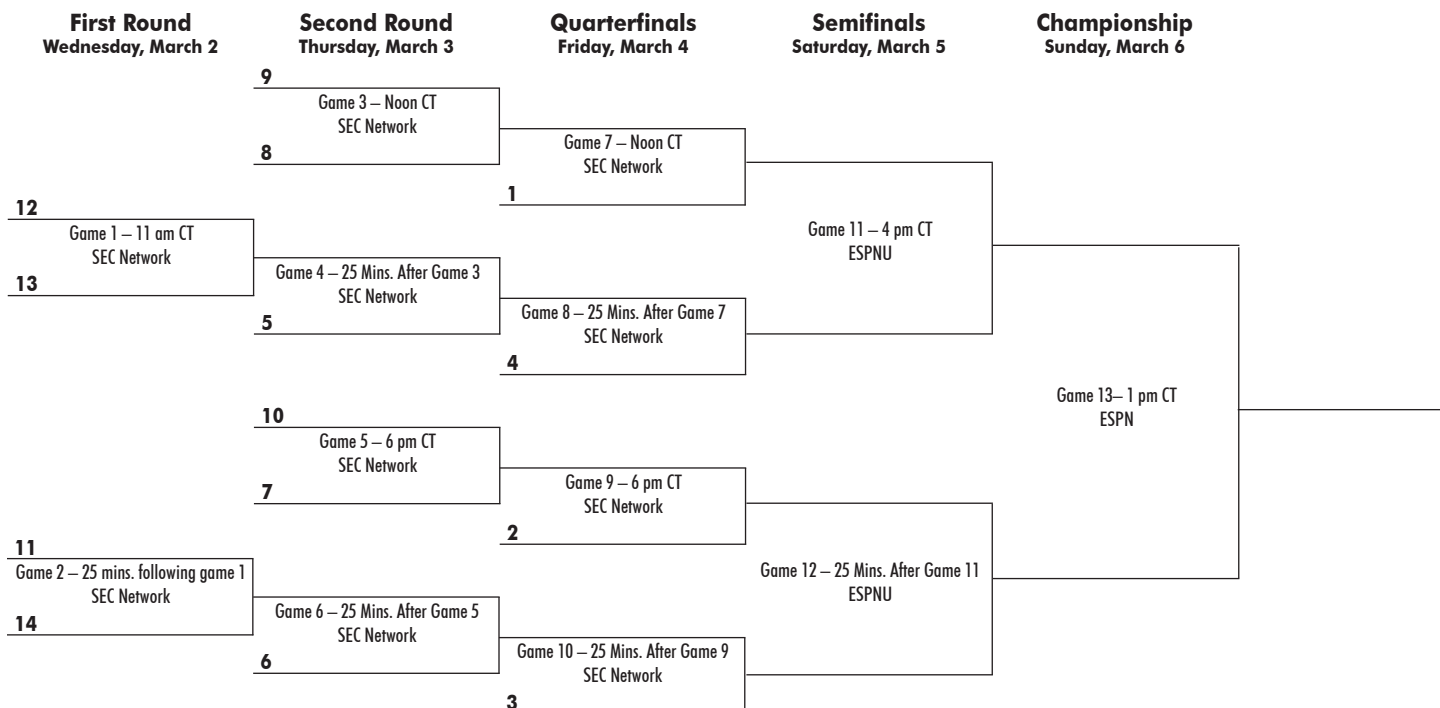

**2022 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BRIDGESTONE ARENA • NASHVILLE, TN**



The Southeastern Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will be played for the seventh time in Nashville, Tenn. when Bridgestone Arena plays host to the 2022 event.

Formerly known as the Nashville Arena, the Gaylord Entertainment Center and the Sommet Center, the building became Bridgestone Arena in 2010. Bridgestone Arena opened in December 1996 and has hosted more than 13 million guests. It is Nashville's number one venue for large-scale musical productions, as well as one of the nation's most highly-acclaimed entertainment and sports venues. Seating capacity is approximately 20,000 for concerts, 19,395 for basketball and 17,113 for Nashville Predators games.

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the 13-game tournament will receive the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds and conference champion will be determined by the 16-game regular-season SEC schedule.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Three of the last 13 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only

twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. Vanderbilt is second with six, while South Carolina has six, Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

**SEC Tournament Tie-Break Procedures**

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
  - A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
  - B) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.
2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
  - B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
  - D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

## SEC Success

- With **nine** national championships, **12** runner-up finishes, a nation-leading **39** Final Four appearances and **153** first-team All-America honors, the Southeastern Conference stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- **Ten** of the current SEC head coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament, **eight** with their respective SEC teams.
- **Six** SEC coaches have helmed teams to the Sweet 16, **five** have advanced to the Elite Eight and **five** have gone on to the Final Four.
- **Five** SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with three winning national championships.
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last **12** seasons.
- **Nine** SEC players were picked in the 2021 WNBA Draft.
- Over the last **12** WNBA Drafts, **68** SEC players have heard their names called, with **26** of those being selected in the first round and **six** as the No. 1 overall pick.
- **Five** WNBA MVPs (Candace Parker: 2008, 2013; Tamika Catchings: 2011; Sylvia Fowles: 2017; A'ja Wilson: 2020) and **six** WNBA Tournament MVPs hail from the SEC (Deanna Nolan: 2006; Seimone Augustus: 2011; Tamika Catchings: 2012; Sylvia Fowles: 2015, 2017; Candace Parker: 2016).
- **Ten** SEC teams (Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Georgia, LSU, Mississippi State, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt) have appeared at least once in the Final Four.
- SEC teams have earned appearances in **29** of **39** NCAA Final Fours, an accomplishment unmatched by any other league. The next closest is the Big East with 23.
- SEC teams have made **21** appearances in a nation-high **18** NCAA Championship games, winning nine NCAA Championships (Tennessee: 1987, 1989, 1991, 1996, 1997, 1998, 2007, 2008); South Carolina (2017).
- Overall, SEC squads have filled **39** of the **156** Final Four berths, including having two Final Four teams in 1988 (Auburn, Tennessee), 1989 (Auburn, Tennessee), 1995 (Georgia, Tennessee), 1996 (Georgia, Tennessee), 1998 (Arkansas, Tennessee), 2004 (LSU, Tennessee), 2005 (LSU, Tennessee), 2007 (LSU, Tennessee), 2008 (LSU, Tennessee), 2017 (Mississippi State, South Carolina).
- A total of **123** women's basketball students were named to the 2020-21 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- Since the 1990 season, the SEC has compiled a **4587-1375 (.769)** record against other conferences. The league has recorded 150+ wins during **13** seasons and has never recorded a non-conference winning percentage below **.703**.
