### CONFERENCE NOTES

#### Weekly Honors

• *Player of the Week:* Graduate student guard Lauren Park-Lane set an individual Mississippi State single-game record (women's or men's) for most threes made with a 10-17 performance from behind the arc at Colorado State on Dec. 21. With the effort, she also became only the third player in SEC women's basketball history to make 10 threes in a single game. She finished with 33 points, 21 of which came in the second half, in addition to a team-high six assists and four rebounds in 35 minutes. It marked her 13th career 30-point game and her seventh contest with 30-plus points and five-plus assists. Park-Lane turned in 12 points, two rebounds and three assists in the fourth quarter to help Mississippi State erase its largest deficit of the season and outscore Colorado State 26-11 in the fourth quarter to escape with the 82-75 road win in a game in which Mississippi State also became the first SEC women's basketball team that Colorado State has hosted at Moby Arena.

• *Freshman of the Week:* Taliah Scott led the Hogs to a 2-0 week at the West Palm Beach Classic, pacing Arkansas in scoring in both contests. She started the week with tying a game-high 17 points off 7-of-15 shooting from the field against preseason ranked Illinois in the buzzer-beater win. She played nearly 38 minutes and drew five fouls. She followed up that performance with a game-high 26 points vs. UIC, while going on a tear from beyond the arc with a career-high six 3-pointers. Scott also matched a career-high six rebounds, added two assists and did not commit any turnovers, while playing all 40 minutes, her third 40-minute game of the year, against the Flames. She was +8 in +/-, which led all players on the stat sheet. The freshman also was huge defensively, taking a pair of charges during the week and coming up with big stops in critical moments of both games. Scott continues to lead the SEC in scoring, as she has since the start of the season, and is the only player in the league to average 20.0+ points per game. Nationally, Scott is second in total points (321) and free throw attempts (86), third in free throw makes (70) and sixth in points per game (22.9). Scott is the fastest freshman at Arkansas in school history to get to 321 points in their first 14 collegiate games.

#### Around the League

- Mississippi State's Darrione Rogers had a triple double against Mississippi Valley State with 14 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists.
- South Carolina's Te-Hina Paopao has hit at least 2 3-pointers in every game this season, hitting that mark early in the second quarter against East Carolina on her way to three total on Saturday. It was her sixth game with three or more from beyond the arc.
- Georgia's Javyn Nicholson tallied her 13th-straight double digit scoring performance with 22 points and tied her career high with 14 rebounds in the win over Wofford.
- Graduate student Jordyn Cambridge collected her second-straight double-double in a 70-52 win over Dayton. Cambridge scored 22 points and pulled down 10 rebounds in her lone game of the week. The guard also collected five steals to move into third place on Vanderbilt's all-time steals list with 287 career steals.

## 2024 SEC TOURNAMENT

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2018, 2022), Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009, 2015), Greenville, S.C. (2005, 2017, 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, 2023, 2024), Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010, 2013, 2014) and Jacksonville, Fla. (2016).

The winner of the tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 31 of the conference tournament champions have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Four of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have gone on to win the national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only twice.

Tennessee leads the league with 17 SEC Tournament titles. South Carolina is second with eight, Vanderbilt has six, while Auburn, Georgia, each have four. LSU has two with Kentucky, Mississippi State and Texas A&M having each won one SEC Tournament championship.

**Tie-Break Procedure**  
Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference standings. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first- and second-round byes and teams that finish No. 5 through No. 10 will receive first-round byes.

- Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:
  - Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
  - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - Coin flip by the Commissioner.
- Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
  - Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
  - If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
  - If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

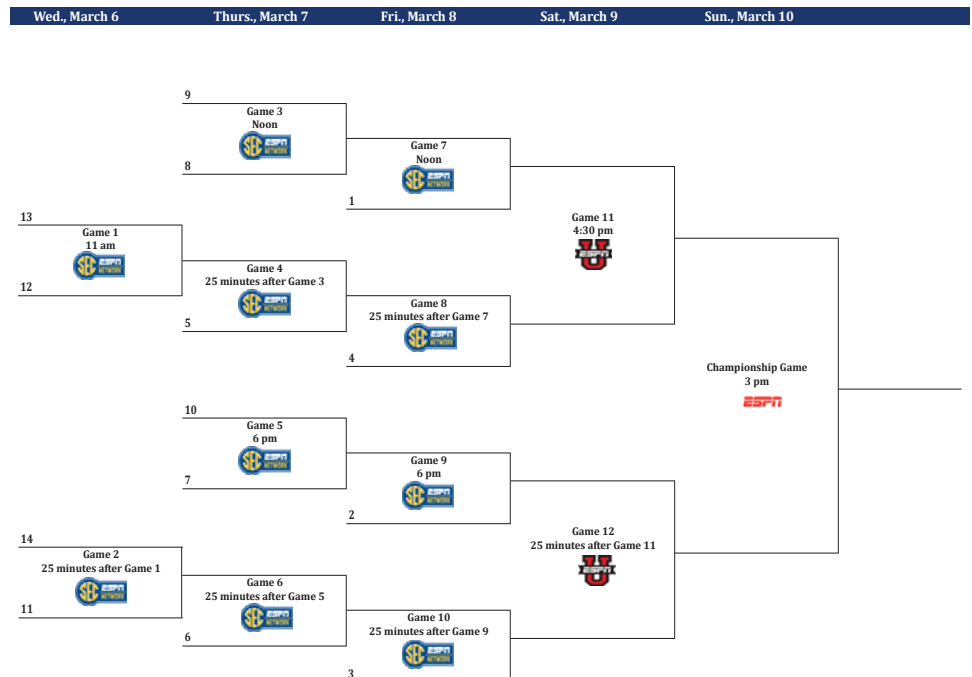
For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will

automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

## SEC SUCCESS

- With 11 national championships, 12 runner-up finishes, a nation-leading 42 Final Four appearances and 167 first-team All-America honors, the SEC stands firmly as the nation's premier intercollegiate women's basketball conference.
- Twelve of the current SEC coaches have led teams to the NCAA Tournament.
- Four SEC coaches have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- Five current SEC coaches have both played and coached in the NCAA Tournament (Katie Abrahamson-Henderson, Kyra Elzy, Kellie Harper, Kim Mulkey and Dawn Staley).
- The SEC has had at least one student-athlete named as a First-Team All-America selection in each of the last 15 seasons.
- All-Americans were first named in women's basketball in 1975. Since that time, league schools have had 80 players named first-team a total of 167 times.
- The SEC has had 159 former players play in the WNBA.
- In this year's WNBA draft, a total of nine SEC women's basketball players were taken.
- Since the inaugural WNBA draft in 1997, the SEC has had 189 former players drafted for the professional league, including seven No. 1 picks.
- The SEC has had a first round pick every year except one (2014).
- Since the SEC began to sponsor women's basketball in 1982, it has failed only five times to place at least four members in each of the final polls (the USA Today/ESPN poll began in 1986).
- The most SEC teams in the final AP poll is seven, which the league has done four times (1996, 1997, 2003, and 2018).
- Overall, the league teams have been ranked every week except for the very first poll in 1976.
- The league has had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.
- A total of 103 women's basketball students were named to the 2022-23 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- The conference has had 36 women's basketball players named Academic All-American.
- SEC schools have produced 45 Team USA Olympians since 1976, with 41 coming since the SEC began sponsoring women's basketball. In addition, seven have played for other countries in the Olympics.
- SEC teams have won 468 NCAA Tournament games against 249 losses (.653) for an average of 11.4 NCAA wins per year.

### Attendance

• SEC women's basketball set the all-time NCAA record for conference leaders in total attendance. A total of 1,146,341 fans passed through its turnstiles during home games and conference tournament action. Overall, the league has five of the Top 10 total attendance seasons.

• The SEC has led the nation in women's basketball average attendance for seven of the last eight seasons.

### SEC vs Everyone Else

• In regular season games, the SEC has compiled a 5991-1746 (.774) record against other conferences.

• In the postseason, SEC teams are 544-249 (.653) against non-conference teams.

• Overall, teams are 6536-1997 (.766).

• The league has recorded 150+ wins in 28 seasons and has recorded a non-conference winning percentage below .700 only once.
