

Throughout the history of golf in the Southeastern Conference, the league has provided a strong tradition of excellence on the links.

The SEC has won 13 men's and four women's golf NCAA crowns in its history with the latest coming in 2015, when LSU captured the men's national championship. The last championship on the women's side was Alabama in 2012. Since 1985, the SEC has captured ten team national titles – six men's and four women's crowns.

During the 2019 season, all but one SEC men's teams advanced to the NCAA Golf Championships, while 12 teams were selected on the women's side.

Since 1985, 63 SEC men's teams have finished in the top 10 of the NCAA Championships, 55 since 1990. The SEC has produced 63 men's first team All-Americans since 1985. On the women's side, 73 teams have broken into the top 10 at the NCAA Championships and 87 individuals have been named first-team All-America, including six in 2018.

Individually, the SEC has seven women's national champions, with Arkansas' Maria Fassi winning the latest title in 2019. On the men's side, Braden Thornberry of Ole Miss won the last title in 2017 to bring the league's total to 12.
