SEC SWIMMING & DIVING ATHLETES OF THE WEEK

Men's Swimmer of the Week: Shaine Casas, Texas A&M

Texas A&M's Shaine Casas, a sophomore from McAllen, Texas, posted nation-leading times to win four individual events as the No. 10 Aggies won the Art Adamson Invitational for the third consecutive year. Casas recorded A-cut times in the 200 IM (1:40.16), the 100 back (44.48) and the 200 back (1:38.21) as well as a B-cut time in the 100 fly (45.26). He is now the eighth fastest performer of all time in the 200 back and 10th fastest swimmer of all time in the 200 IM. Casas was also a part of the winning 400 medley relay (3:06.68/45.57).

Men's Diver of the Week: Zach Allen, Georgia

Georgia's Zach Allen, a junior from Fort Lauderdale, Fla., swept the springboard events to score a team-high 57 points at the Tennessee Invitational. He earned the gold in the 1-meter with a score of 354.80 and in the 3-meter with a score of 371.85. Allen closed the weekend with a second-place finish on platform with a final score of 247.50.

Men's Freshman of the Week: Manny Vazquez Bas, LSU

LSU's Manny Vazquez Bas, a freshman from San Juan, Puerto Rico, won the platform at the Art Adamson Invitational with a final score of 356.50. He earned a third-place finish in the 3-meter springboard with a career-high score of 378.05 and sixth place on the 1-meter with a final score of 307.40.

Women's Swimmer of the Week: Erika Brown, Tennessee

Tennessee's Erika Brown, a senior from Charlotte, N.C., won three individual events with nation-leading times as No. 2 Tennessee finished first at the Tennessee Invitational. Brown also helped the Lady Vols secure three relay event wins and two nation-leading times. She posted NCAA A-cut times in the 50 free (21.19), the 100 free (46.15), the 200 free (1:41.66) and the 100 fly (49.79), as well as B-cuts in the 200 IM (1:57.61) and the 100 back (52.02). Brown swam second for the 200 free relay (1:27.20/21.10) and the 800 free relay (7:01.54/1:43.51), and anchor on the 400 free relay (3:11.27/45.92). She now owns two of the fastest 50 free times in history (21.15 and 21.19), is the second fastest performer in history in the 100 free (46.15), the fourth fastest performer in history in the 100 fly (49.79) and the ninth fastest performer in history in the 200 free (1:41.66).

Women's Diver of the Week: Aimee Wilson, LSU

LSU's Aimee Wilson, a sophomore from Calgary, Canada, placed first on the 1-meter springboard at the Art Adamson Invitational with a final score of 328.45. Wilson was runner-up on the 3-meter with a season-high score of 345.75. Opening the season on platform, she registered 230.70 points, good for seventh place.

Women's Freshman of the Week: Zoie Hartman, Georgia

Georgia's Zoie Hartman, a freshman from Danville, Calif., posted one A-cut and two B-cuts at the Tennessee Invitational. Hartman broke Kristy Kowal's 21-year record with a prelim time of 58.76 before improving on her record time with a mark of 58.27 in the final, the best finish of any collegiate swimmer in the event, as well as the nation's current top time. She finished second in the 200 IM with a time of 1:53.69 (third fastest time in the nation) and the 200 breaststroke with a time of 2:07.43 (second fastest time in the nation). Hartman also swam in five relays, including the 400 medley relay, where her 100 breaststroke split of 57.84 was the best relay split in school history.

» Alabama

At the Georgia Tech Invitational, sophomore Rhyan White broke the school 100 butterfly mark, going 52.11 before becoming the first UA woman under 52 seconds in the event in finals going 51.71 to take the win. She also bettered her own school record in the 100 backstroke for the third time in two days to win the race with a 51.12, bettering the mark she set in prelims (51.44) after first lowering it on Friday (51.93) to lead off the Tide's 400 medley relay. To start off finals, she led off the Tide's record-breaking 200 medley relay, combining with juniors Kaila Wong and Flora Molnar and senior Allie Surrency in going 1:36.50, bettering the previous standard set in 2018. After breaking the school mark of the 200 backstroke in Sunday's prelims with a 1:52.14, White dropped it more than two seconds in finals, posting a 1:50.00 to take the win and the nation's top time. In prelims, she shattered another team record, going 1:55.78 in the 200 butterfly, bettering the previous mark set in 2010 by more than a second. Senior Zane Waddell won the 50 freestyle with a 19.20 and led off the Tide's winning 400 medley relay, joining freshman Liam Bell, junior Tyler Sesvold and sophomore Jonathan Berneburg in finishing more than two seconds ahead of the field with a 3:07.51. On day two of the invite, the Tide women closed the night with another school record when senior Alexis Preski, sophomore Kensey McMahon, sophomore Morgan Scott and junior Flora Molnar went 7:08.69, bettering the previous mark set in 2016. The Tide men also picked up a win, opening finals by winning the 200 medley relay. Seniors Waddell and Kyle Maas combined with junior Tyler Sesvold and sophomore Jonathan Berneburg to stop the clock with a 1:24.43, bettering the field by more than three tenths of a second. To close out the weekend, Molnar posted a school-record 48.15 in the prelims of the 100 freestyle, before becoming the first UA woman under 48 seconds in finals, going 47.98 to earn the win. Freshman diver Tanesha Lucoe notched another Tide win, taking top honors off the platform with 254.70 points, six ahead of the rest of the field. The Crimson Tide closed out the meet with a school record in the 400 freestyle relay, with sophomores Scott and Julia Wolf combining with Molnar and senior Allie Surrency to go 3:14.26. Alabama closes the fall semester with a pair of trips to Auburn, Ala., taking on the Tigers in a dual meet on Dec. 5, before returning Dec. 17-19 for the Auburn Diving Invite.

» Arkansas

Senior Anna Hopkin started off the Mizzou Invite with a bang, posting the fastest 50 free in the country. Additionally, Hopkin made the NCAA "A" cut for the 50 free, broke the pool record and broke the school record. She rallied for the 50 free Final A cut finishing with a time of 21.19. Junior Peyton Palsha finished first in the 500 free with a time of 4:38.86, breaking the school record and earning NCAA "B" cut. On day two, Hopkin posted the fastest time in the nation this year in the 200 free with a time of 1:44.40 to break her own school record. Her meet-record time also earned her a NCAA "B" qualifier along with Vanessa Herrmann, who touched the wall in 1:00.54 in the 100 breast. Pasha set a new personal best in the 400 IM with the fourth-fastest time in the nation this year with a time of 4:11.14. Her swim also notched her a NCAA "B" cut. Hopkin posted the fifth-best performance in split history in the 200-medley relay, with a 20.76 anchor leg as the Hogs came in second with a time of 1:37.34. The senior went on to swim the fastest 100 free in the nation this year, touching the wall in 46.56. The Razorbacks return to the pool on Dec. 4 at the U.S. Open in Atlanta, Ga.

» Auburn

The No. 13 Auburn women placed second at the Wolfpack Invite, runner-up to No. 7 NC State, while the No. 23 Auburn men earned a fourth-place finish. Sophomore Emily Hetzer finished second in the 500 free with a lifetime-best time of 4:38.87, the fourth-fastest time in the event in Auburn history. Senior Julie Meynen also swam a lifetime best in the 50 free, finishing in 21.80 to earn first place to move into fourth all-time in program history. Fisch and Meynen, along with fellow senior Robyn Clevenger and freshman AJ Kutsch, combined to win the 200 free relay (1:28.09) in the first event of the finals session Thursday. After earning a personal-best score during the prelims, Auburn sophomore Conner Pruitt turned around and won the 3-meter competition in the finals with 398.50 points. After finishing third in the 1-meter competition the first day, senior Alison Maillard bounced back to win the 3-meter event with 347.25 points on Friday night. On the final night, Meynen and Fisch finished 1-2 in the 100 free for the Tigers. (47.73 and 48.20). With platform diving competition the first time this season, junior Logan Andrews led the way for the men, finishing in fourth with 291.90 points. Maillard (229.50) and freshman Gretchen Wensuc (227.70) finished third and fourth respectively while fellow freshman Ashlynn Sullivan placed 10th overall with 212.25 points. On Thursday, Dec. 5, Auburn will return home to face in-state rival Alabama in a dual meet at the James E. Martin Aquatics Center.

» Florida

Men: No. 6 Florida finished in fifth place at the Georgia Tech Invitational. Robert Finke took home the 1,650 free by 13 seconds, securing a B-cut with his effort of 14:47.51. The win marked the third-fastest time in the NCAA. Kevin Vargas dominated the field in the 400 IM finals, beating the field by almost five full seconds (3:46.14). Ethan Beach posted a third-place finish and a B-cut with his finals time of 1:44.04, improving on his time from the morning that was the second-fastest for the event. Dakota Mahaffey qualified for the 200 back finals as well, producing a season-best time of 1:45.93 and a first-place B-final finish. The invitational marked the final competition for some Gators, as part of the team will travel to the US Open in Atlanta on Dec. 4-7. Florida's divers will compete in the Auburn Diving Invitational in Alabama on Dec. 17-19.

Women: Leah Braswell's nation-leading 1,650 free swim on the final day of the Georgia Tech Invitational guided No. 1 Florida to win the three-day event with 1,211 points. Braswell beat the field in the 1,650 free by 16 seconds after posting an A-cut and personal-best time of 15:47.85. The time is the third-fastest time in school history. Her previous best set last year at SEC Championships was fifth-best all-time. Braswell also won the 500 free (4:37.25), while Kelly Fertel won the 200 IM (1:56.29). Fertel walked away with her second individual victory in Atlanta, winning the Gator-filled 400 IM final with a swim of 4:07.58. Teammates Savanna Faulconer and Kathleen Golding would round-out the top-three swims, including Golding hitting a new personal-best time of 4:10.24. The 400 free relay team of Bella Garofalo, Sherridon Dressel, Emma Ball and Talia Bates combined for the ninth-fastest swim in program history as the group posted an effort of 3:15.22. Ball and Bates posted identical splits of 48.52 to lead UF. The 200 free relay team of Garofalo, Ball, Dressel and Bates combined for the top swim of 1:28.36, securing an A-cut in the process. The 200 medley relay of Ball, Fertel, Dressel and Bates posted the fourth-fastest relay in UF history with their combined A-cut swim of 1:36.71. Bates hit the fastest split, anchoring the relay with a 50 free swim of 21.88. Ashley McCool paced Florida's 3-meter diving efforts in the evening final. The junior would tally an overall score of 349.15, 4.37 points higher than her previous personal-best against Missouri and good for a second-place finish. The invitational marked the final competition for the swimmers in 2019. Florida's divers will compete in the Auburn Diving Invitational in Alabama on Dec. 17-19.



» **Georgia**

At the Tennessee Invitational, the No. 12 Bulldog men claimed the overall invitational victory with 961 points, besting No. 4 Indiana by 19, while the No. 8 Lady Bulldogs placed second with 984.5 points, trailing only the second-ranked Tennessee Lady Volunteers at 1068.5 points. In the men's 500 free, Georgia swept the podium finish, with Walker Higgins taking first (4:13.05), Kevin Miller earning second (4:15.70) and Andrew Abruzzo placing third (4:16.63). Zach Allen took the top spot in the men's 3-meter springboard with a final score of 371.85, and Josh Getty finished third with a final score of 316.65. Allen also earned the gold in the men's 1-meter with a final score of 354.80. Camden Murphy bested the field in the 100 fly with a time of 45.36, and Clayton Ford came in first place in the 400 IM with a time of 3:42.14. Freida Lim placed first in women's platform diving, posting a final score of 261.60. Allen took second in men's platform with a score of 247.50. In the women's 200 fly, Dakota Luther came in first (1:53.22), followed by teammate Courtney Harnish (1:54.39) in second. The full team will return to competition against Texas A&M on Saturday, Jan. 11 at Gabrielsen Natatorium.

» **Kentucky**

At the Ohio State Fall Open Invitational, No. 21 Kentucky men finished second behind host and No. 16 Ohio State and the No. 15 UK women came in fifth place. Asia Seidt posted an NCAA B cut time of 1:55.62 to win the women's 200 IM, while Glen Brown did the same in the men's 200 IM with a time of 1:45.07. Seidt, Caitlin Brooks and Ali Gayler went 1-2-3 in the women's 100 back with B-cut times to sweep the podium. Seidt, Galyer and Brooks also swept the top three spots in the women's 200 back with a trio of B-cut times. UK went 1-2-3 in the women's 200 breaststroke with B-cut times from Gillian Davey, Bailey Bonnett and Lauren Poole. Peter Wetzlar touched the wall first in the men's 50 free with a B-cut time of 19.73. Ali Galyer posted a B-cut time to win the women's 200 free (1:44.64). The women's 400 medley relay squad of Brooks, Bonnett, Seidt and Galyer finished first with a B-cut time of 3:31.67. Seidt, Beth McNeese, Riley Gaines and Galyer placed first in the women's 800 free relay with a B-cut time of 7:01.40. The quartet of Seidt, Galyer, Gaines and Kaitlynn Wheeler earned the gold in the women's 400 free relay with a time of 3:16.42. Select swimmers will compete at USA Swimming Winter Nationals Dec. 4-7 at McCauley Aquatic Center in Atlanta. The long-course meet is an opportunity for swimmers to earn 2020 U.S. Olympic Trials cut times. Meanwhile, select divers will compete at the Miami (Ohio) Invitational Dec. 6-7 at Corwin M. Nixon Aquatic center in Oxford, Ohio.

» **LSU**

The LSU women's team won the SMU Invitational with 976.5 points, and the men's team finished in second place with 755 points. Cassie Kalisz set a school record with a 1:54.76 to take the gold in the women's 200 back. Kalisz earned a first-place finish in the 100 back with a time of 52.98. In the 200 breaststroke, Niamh Robinson set a new LSU record to win the event with a time of 2:08.88. Robinson also won the 100 breaststroke with a time of 1:00.63, the seventh-best time in program history. Katarina Milutinovich took the top spot in the women's 200 free with a time of 1:47.68, which ties for the eighth best time in school history. Lewis Clough earned the gold medal in the men's 100 fly, winning the event for the third time this season with a time of 47.85. Three Tigers finished in the top four in the men's 50 free as Matt Klotz took the top spot with a time of 19.67. Brooks Curry and Jack Jannasch finished second (20.03) and fourth (20.22), respectively. Curry won the men's 200 free with a time of 1:36.08, the fourth best time in program history. Klotz and David Wahlen finished first and second in the men's 100 back with times of 47.58 and

48.64, respectively. The team of Milutinovich, Olivia Taylor, Helen Grossman and Grace Horton took the top spot in the women's 200 free relay with a time of 1:31.00. Milutinovich, Taylor, Grossman and Horton touched the wall in 3:20.01 to take the top spot in the women's 400 free relay. The team of Kalisz, Olivia Paskulin, Grossman and Milutinovich finished first in the women's 400 medley relay with a time of 3:37.89. Kalisz, Paskulin, Grossman and Taylor won the women's 200 medley relay with a time of 1:39.75. Milutinovich, Summer Stanfield, Jolee Liles and Taylor took the top spot in the women's 800 free relay with a time of 7:20.75. The men's squad took the top spot in the 200 free relay. The team of Curry, Lewis Clough, Jannasch and Klotz touched the wall in 1:18.46. Klotz, Luca Pfyffer, Clough, and Curry touched the wall in 3:12.25 to win the men's 400 medley relay. The team of Curry, Ben Hooper, Keagan Finley and Cameron Karkoska won the men's 800 free relay with a time of 6:33.16. At the Art Adamson Invitational in College Station, Manny Vazquez Bas took the top spot on the men's platform with a score of 356.50. Dakota Hurbis finished in fourth place with a score of 264.50. On the women's side, Anne Tuxen came in fourth place with a score of 250.85, Hayley Montague finished in fifth place with a 247.90, and Aimee Wilson came in seventh place with a 230.70. This was the first platform competition of the season for the Tigers. Wilson earned the top spot in the women's 1-meter with a score of 328.45.

» **Missouri**

No. 3/9 Mizzou men's and women's swimming and diving teams swept the 2019 Mizzou Invite team titles on Friday, Nov. 22 after notching four NCAA A cuts and setting three school records during the three-day meet at the Mizzou Aquatic Center. The Tiger women scored 942.5 points to win the women's title ahead of 12 other programs. Arkansas (659) placed second, San Diego State (585) took third, Nebraska (384) was fourth and BYU (354) rounded out the top five. On the men's side, the Tigers totaled 1,253.5 points to take first among seven total teams. BYU (816) finished second, Drury (671.5) was third, Wyoming (495) took fourth and Oklahoma Baptist (228) placed fifth. Missouri concluded the meet with a pair of nation-leading 400 free relay times, including an NCAA A cut for the Tiger men. First, the women's relay of junior Sarah Thompson, senior Haley Hynes, sophomore Megan Keil and freshman Amy Feddersen raced back in dramatic fashion to beat out Arkansas, 3:14.88-3:14.90. The Mizzou men dropped an NCAA automatic qualifying time as sophomore Danny Kovac, senior Giovanni Lima and sophomores Kyle Leach and Jack Dahlgren touched in 2:50.79. Individually, Dahlgren twice posted a nation-leading time in the 200 back during final day competition. He first swam a 1:41.82 in prelims, then lowered than time to a 1:41.66 to win the event during the finals session. Also notching a nation-leading time was senior Micah Slaton, who recorded his in the 200 fly. Slaton dropped a 1:42.28 in prelims and was just off that time in finals, as he touched in 1:42.30, to take top honors in the event. Mizzou won both platform diving events on Friday, as sophomore Ike Khamis and freshman Maddie Huiitt took the men's and women's competitions. Khamis notched a finals tally of 371.4, including an 86.4 on his fourth dive, to best freshman teammate Carlo Lopez by almost four points. Huiitt grabbed her first collegiate win with a finals tally of 276.4, which ranks her fourth all-time at Mizzou on the event. A pair of Tiger freshmen, Katrina Brathwaite and Will Goodwin swept the 200 breast in personal best times. Brathwaite touched in 2:10.89 for first on the women's side, and Goodwin went 1:55.29 to win the men's race. Thompson and sophomore Jack Dubois also claimed wins on Friday. Thompson swam a personal best 1:52.88 to win the 200 back, and Dubois went 15:05.03 to place first in the 1650 free. The Tigers are idle until the divers compete at the Auburn Diving Invitational, Dec. 16-19, in Auburn, Ala.



» **South Carolina**

At the Georgia Tech Fall Invitational, the South Carolina men tied for seventh place with East Carolina University with 112 points apiece, while the South Carolina women finished seventh with 107 points. Sophomore Anton Down-Jenkins took home the win in the men's 3-meter springboard with a score of 433.15. Christina Lappin who twice broke her own school record in the women's 100 fly. Lappin opened the day with a record-breaking 52.60 in the prelims, shaving 0.01 off her existing school record. Later that evening, she lowered the mark again to 52.43, which was good for fifth place in the event's A-final. Senior Albury Higgs won the 200 breaststroke with a time of 2:10.96. The diving squad will be back in action Dec. 15-19 for the Auburn Invitational, while the full team will resume action Jan. 11 when the Gamecocks take on East Carolina on the road.

» **Tennessee**

The No. 2 Lady Vols finished the Tennessee Invitational atop the standings with 1,068.5 points, ahead of No. 8 Georgia (984.5), No. 4 Virginia (778), No. 16 Indiana (656) and Carson-Newman (138). UNC Asheville only competed in diving, scoring 11 points. The No. 8 Tennessee men's team finished third at the invitational with 839.5 points. No. 12 Georgia won with 961 while No. 4 Indiana had 942 to place second. No. 18 Virginia finished fourth with 524.5 points and Carson-Newman rounded out the men's side with 180. Erika Brown took home the gold in the women's 50 free (21.19), the 100 fly (49.79) and the 100 free (46.15). Tess Cieplucha touched the wall first in the women's 400 IM (4:03.06), and Molly Hannis captured the top spot in the women's 100 breaststroke (57.88). Meghan Small earned a first-place finish in the women's 200 back with a time of 1:52.20. Kyle Decoursey and Alec Connolly went 1-2 in the men's 50 free, with Decoursey finishing at 19.34 and Connolly at 19.47. Michael Houlie took first place in the men's 100 breaststroke (52.32). Matthew Dunphy and Houlie took the top two podium spots in the men's 200 breaststroke, with Dunphy coming in first at 1:55.60 and Houlie second at 1:55.95. The women's 200 free relay team of Bailey Grinter, Erika Brown, Megan Sichter and Stanzi Moseley took first with a time of 1:27.20. Small, Brown, Cieplucha and Tjasa Pintar combined to finish first in the women's 800 free relay with a time of 7:01.54. The 400 free relay of Grinter, Moseley, Pintar and Brown placed first with a time of 3:11.27. The men's 200 medley relay squad of Matthew Garcia, Houlie, Braga Verhade and Connolly placed first with a time of 1:24.85. Grace Cable placed first in the women's 1-meter springboard with a final score of 299.05 and first on the 3-meter with a final score of 310.20. Cable placed second on the platform with a score of 218.50. Keegan Richardson finished first on men's platform with a final score of 297.30. The Vol and Lady Vol divers will compete at the Auburn Diving Invitational Dec. 17-19 before hosting the Tennessee Diving Invitational on Jan. 3-5.

» **Texas A&M**

Men: No. 10 Texas A&M set eight new school records throughout the three-day meet to win the Art Adamson Invite for the third year in a row on Nov. 23 at the Rec Center Natatorium. The Aggies ended with a score of 1,322, more than second-place USC's and third-place Hawaii's scores combined. Within three days, Shaine Casas set five school records, three pool records and became the national leader in three different events. The sophomore speedster broke school records and earned first place in each of his individual races throughout the three-day meet, in addition to setting the A&M 100 back record in his leadoff swim of the 400 medley relay. Casas set the record in the 200 back with an NCAA A-cut time of 1:38.21 and is tied as the eighth fastest performer in the event. Adam Koster reset his own school record in the 100 free with NCAA

B-cut time of 42.26. Andres Puente won the 200 breast with new personal-best and NCAA A-cut time of 1:52.48. In the concluding event of the meet, Shaine Casas, Adam Koster, Kaloyan Bratanov and Mark Theall notched a school record and NCAA A-cut time of 2:49.99. The men's team will return to action in a double-dual against Trinity University and Incarnate Word at the Palo Alto Pool in San Antonio, Texas on Dec. 16.

Women: No. 20 Texas A&M finished out the Art Adamson Invite in second place, earning 1,098.5 points, trailing Stanford by only 210.5 points. The women earned several Olympic Trial cut times in the morning, racking up to 11 for the weekend. The Aggies also cleared multiple NCAA B-cut times today, earning nine from the invite. Alyssa Clairmont competed in the platform dive for the Aggies. Clairmont placed first (304.85) in her collegiate debut on the tower. Jing Wen Quah (2:12.93) and Taylor Pike (2:14.32) secured their Olympic Trial cut times in 200 LC Fly in the morning. Four Aggies earned NCAA B-cut times in 200 Breast, as Anna Belousova finished second (2:08.23), Caroline Theil in seventh (2:12.01), Kylie Powers in tenth (2:12.96) and Victoria Roubique in 11th (2:13.27). Raena Eldridge locked her NCAA B-cut in the 100 Free (49.08), while Pike secured hers in the in 200 Fly (1:54.81). Joy Field notched second in the 1650 Free (16:07.44), also earning a NCAA B-cut time. The Maroon & White return to the pool in Dallas, Texas on January 9th at 5 p.m. in a dual meet against SMU.

» **Vanderbilt**

The Vanderbilt swimming team concluded the TYR '85 Invite in third place at the Liberty Natatorium. In the finals of the 500-yard freestyle, junior Lara Hernandez-Tome finished in 4:59.10 to claim sixth place in the A final followed by sophomore Krislyn Porter tabbing seventh (5:00.59). In the 50-yard freestyle finals, sophomore Tonner DeBeer claimed first place by touching the wall at 23.24 in the A final. Closing out day one with the 400-yard medley relay, the Vanderbilt A relay notched a third-place finish in 3:46.55. Abby Burke, Lizzy Colwell, DeBeer and Chantal Jordan claimed first place in the 200 medley relay, finishing in a season-best time of 1:41.28. Kicking off the finals with the 100-yard butterfly, DeBeer earned a silver-worthy finish by touching the wall at 54.12, marking her season-best in the event. Earning a top performance, Colwell touched in at 1:01.76 in the 100 breaststroke to take first place. With this time Colwell earns her personal best and a NCAA B cut. Junior Lindsey Gordon tabbed second place by finishing in 1:03.50. In the 100 backstroke, DeBeer lead the Does with a third-place finish (54.85). In the 1650 free, junior Lara Hernandez-Tome collected her first win of the Invite by touching in at 16.49.69. In the 200-yard breaststroke, Colwell notched her second victory of the weekend with a season-best time of 2:15.59. The Commodores return to action Jan. 1 at Campbell in the first meet of 2020.
