TUITION GIVEAWAY DETAILS

STEP 1

IDENTIFY GO TEACH TUITION GIVEAWAY RECIPIENTS

Each participating institution will have the opportunity to select one student to receive a Dr Pepper Go Teach Tuition valued at \$2,500 each

Recipients must meet the following criteria:

- Student must have participated in an NCAA sponsored sport
- Enrolled in or applying to enroll in a teacher preparation program at the institution, an affiliated education program or an alternative teacher certificate program

Provide CFPF with the list of recipients and a completed online form for each recipient by Friday, November 13, 2020. The response should include a brief statement about why the recipient wants to be a teacher.

FAQs

Does my school or institution need to be a Go Teach school?

No, you do not currently have to be actively participating in the Go Teach project to receive these funds

Is this intended to be a postgraduate scholarship?

Not necessarily. It can support a student-athlete at any point on their path to become a teacher.

Is this supposed to go only to those who are majoring in education?

No. We've found that on some campuses there are multiple pathways to obtain a teaching certification along with the degree (College of Liberal Arts, College of Natural Sciences etc.).

Can this tuition support go to any student-athlete who has concrete plans to get a teaching certificate after graduation?

Yes, it could. There are some who pursue a teaching certificate through programs such as Teach for America or other alternative programs after they graduate. If that's what they're planning to do we would support it. We would be able to provide the tuition support if they are enrolling in one of our Go Teach Project approved alternative certification programs.
