• **SEC Gymnast of the Week** – Auburn’s Sunisa Lee, a sophomore from St. Paul, Minn., won the all-around at No. 11 Alabama with a 39.825, tying the nation-leading score for the 2023 season. Lee recorded 10.0s on bars and beam, the first meet of her career with perfect marks. She also registered a 9.90 on vault to finish second and a 9.925 on floor to tie for third place. Lee’s performance helped Auburn post a season-high score of 197.700 on the road and the first time that the Tigers have scored a 197+ in Tuscaloosa in program history.

• **SEC Specialist of the Week** – LSU’s KJ Johnson, a sophomore from Dallas, Texas, matched her career-high score on floor with a 9.95 to tie for second place in the win over No. 17 Georgia. Johnson also placed fourth on vault with a score of 9.875 as the Tigers garnered the top four finishes in the event.

• **SEC Freshman of the Week** – Florida’s Kayla DiCello, a freshman from Boyds, Md., led the SEC freshmen last week with her all-around score of 39.475 in the win at No. 18 Arkansas. DiCello finished third to be a part of the Gator sweep in the all-around. She posted a collegiate-best 9.95 to finish second, and tied her collegiate best of 9.925 on bars to take third place. DiCello also shared fourth place on vault with her second-highest mark of the season of 9.875.

The No. 11 Alabama gymnastics team defeated the Auburn Tigers, 197.850-197.700, in front of a sold-out Coleman Coliseum crowd on February 3. The Crimson Tide earned its highest score of the season on both balance beam and floor exercise, with UA's 49.700 rotation total on floor the highest on the event in the nation this season.

Following a 49.175 on the vault to open the meet, the Tide's rotation scores got higher after each rotation. Alabama followed a 49.325 on the uneven bars with a 49.650 on the balance beam, tying for the second-highest total on the event in program history. The Tide closed out the night with a 49.700 on floor exercise, tying a program record on the event.

Luisa Blanco scored a perfect 10 on the balance beam and anchor Alabama in the third rotation of the night, earning the second 10.0 of her career. Blanco posted a 39.750 in the all-around, tying her career high on the vault (9.950), the balance beam (10.0) and floor exercise (9.975), receiving at least one 10.0 from a judge on all three events.

Sophomore Lilly Hudson also earned a pair of 9.975s on both balance beam and floor exercise, both career-highs for the sophomore. Hudson also tied her career-high in the all-around with a 39.575, matching her total from last Friday's meet at Kentucky.

Alabama heads back out on the road to Fort Worth, Texas, to compete in the Metroplex Challenge on Saturday, February 11. Alabama will face off against defending NCAA Champion Oklahoma as well as Arkansas and Stanford. The meet will follow the postseason format and will take place on podium.

In the return to Bud Walton Arena, No. 18 Arkansas fell to No. 2 Florida, 197.400-197.875 in front of a program-record 11,031 fans.

The score is the Hogs' third-highest ever as a program, and a record in Bud Walton Arena. Arkansas also earned a beam best for 2023 with a 49.350, and outscored Florida on floor, 49.475-49.250.

Lauren Williams earned a share of the floor title with a personal high of 9.950, and fellow freshman Cally Swaney earned career bests on both bars (9.85) and beam (9.925). Her beam score was good for third place. Redshirt freshman Frankie Price earned a share of second place on vault with a 9.90.

The Gymbacks earned two podium finishes on floor, with Williams taking a share of first place and Price finishing third with a 9.925.

Arkansas hits the road for a quad meet next week in Fort Worth, Texas. The Metroplex Challenge with the Hogs, Stanford, Oklahoma and Alabama is set for Saturday, February 11 at 7:15 p.m.

Competing in Tuscaloosa for the first time, sophomore Sunisa Lee scored 10s on her opening and closing events to lead No. 6 Auburn to a season-high 197.7 on February 3 at Coleman Coliseum. The Tigers grabbed an early lead and held on through three rotations before No. 11 Alabama closed with a whopping 49.7 on floor to total 197.850 to record a rivalry victory.

On bars, senior Cassie Stevens tallied a 9.9 while sophomore Sophia Groth and fifth year Derrian Gobourne each added 9.875s to set up Lee's fabulous finale. Juniors Olivia Hollingsworth and Gabby McLaughlin each scored 9.75s.

Lee led the way again on vault, pacing the Tigers with a 9.9. Groth, Stevens and Gobourne each added 9.85s while Hollingsworth led off with a career-high 9.875 to help the Tigers score 49.325 in the rotation to maintain Auburn's .225 lead.

Moving to floor for the third rotation, Lee and Gobourne led the Tigers with matching 9.925s at the bottom of the lineup. Groth followed senior Aria Brusch's opening 9.825 with a season-high 9.9. Hollingsworth contributed a 9.85 with Stevens scoring 9.875 to give Auburn 49.475.

Despite that big score, Alabama closed the gap considerably through three events by scoring 49.65 on beam, highlighted by Luisa Blanco's 10. Heading to the final rotation, Auburn led 148.2-148.150, only half a tenth separating the rivals in a pressure-packed last event.

After Hollingsworth led off on beam with a 9.8, Brusch equaled her season high with a 9.9 in the second spot to keep the pressure on the home team. Stevens equaled her career high with a 9.95. Groth added a 9.85 and Lee anchored with her second beam 10 of the season to win the all-around with 39.825. That total tied her career best in the category. Stevens tied for third in the all-around with 39.575.

Auburn returns to Neville Arena Friday, February 10 to host LSU at 7:30 p.m. CT on SEC Network.

A couple of 10.0s by Florida's Leanne Wong and season highs on a pair of events helped No. 2 Florida take the win at No. 18 Arkansas, 197.875 – 197.40 win, on February 3 in front of a record crowd of 11,031 at Bud Walton Arena.

Florida's 197.875 stands as the nation's eighth-highest as the season's enters its second month.

Florida equaled the nation's high uneven bars total for the second time this season to open competition. Highlighting the lineup was Wong's second 10.0 bars mark of the season. Three other Gators posted collegiate or season high bars marks – Trinity Thomas (9.975), Kayla DiCello (9.925) and Victoria Nguyen (9.90).

Payton Richards led off Florida's vault lineup with the evening's winning mark of 9.925, a season best for Richards. Thomas shared second at 9.9 with Arkansas' Frankie Price.

Thomas anchored the Gators' floor set with a 9.95, sharing the event win with Arkansas' Lauren Williams. Wong also posted a 9.90 and Rachel Baumann turned in a 9.875 for the second consecutive week.

Wong finished her evening just as she started it – with a 10.0. The sophomore closed her evening with her second perfect mark of 2023 on balance beam. DiCello also turned in her second collegiate best of the night, with a 9.95 to take second overall. Florida's beam total of 49.60 set the team season high on the event.

It was a Gator all-around sweep. Wong took her second consecutive all-around win and third of 2023 at 39.775. Thomas was second (39.70) and DiCello was third (39.475).

Florida will host Missouri for the 17th Annual Gators Link to Pink meet on Friday, February 10. Start time at Stephen C. O'Connell Center is slated for 6:45 p.m. and will air live on SEC Network.

The No. 9 LSU Gymnastics team defeated No. 17 Georgia, 197.700-196.925, on February 3 in the PMAC.

A crowd of 12,099 fans showed out to watch the Tigers post a season-high score to defeat the Bulldogs for the sixth-straight time in the PMAC. Sophomore Aleah Finnegan recorded her first career perfect 10 on floor to boost the Tigers to a season-high floor score of 49.675 and help LSU secure the win.

LSU started off strong on vault, scoring a 49.475. Finnegan earned a 9.900, and junior Chase Broke put up a career-high 9.95 to help the Tigers get off to a strong start. Sophomore KJ Johnson recorded a 9.875, and junior Haleigh Bryant anchored with a 9.975 of her own to take the title.

On bars, sophomore Alexis Jeffrey led off with a 9.900. Finnegan scored a 9.850 in the fourth spot, while senior Alyona Shchennikova followed with a 9.875. Bryant anchored with a 9.900 to close the second rotation with a score of 49.300. Jeffrey and Bryant, along with Georgia's Haley De Jong, won the event with their performances.

Ob beam, Schennikova scored a 9.850. Bryant and Finnegan both recorded 9.900's to take the co-title as LSU scored a 49.250 for the third rotation.

Both Shchennikova and Bryant scored a 9.925 on floor, while KJ Johnson matched her career high with a 9.950. Finnegan earned her first career perfect score in the fifth spot to take the win.

Bryant finished the night with her sixth all-around title in six meets with a 39.700. Her performance against Georgia marked the second meet this season that she has scored 9.900+ on all four events. Finnegan's 10 marked the first in her career and third title on floor this season. The sophomore finished the night with a career high all-around score of 39.650. Shchennikova owned a season-high all-around score of 39.400.

The Tigers will be back in action on Friday, February 10, as they travel to take on Auburn for a 7:30 p.m. CT tilt on SEC Network.

The No. 14 University of Missouri gymnastics team returned home to face No. 10 Kentucky on February 3 at Hearnes Center. The Tigers kept pace with the Wildcats, but ultimately fell 197.325 to 196.600 in a narrow duel.

The Tigers' vault rotation scored a collective 49.325, edging the Wildcats in the opening event. Missouri was led by sophomores Jocelyn Moore and Amari Celestine, who each scored a season-high 9.950 and 9.875, respectively. Graduate student Hannah McCrary (9.850), junior Sienna Schreiber (9.850), sophomore Grace Anne Davis (9.800) and junior Sydney Schaffer (9.725) also competed in the rotation.

Missouri continued its outing with the bar rotation, led by senior Helen Hu in the anchor spot with a 9.900 score. Moore and Schreiber finished narrowly behind her, both scoring 9.850. Graduate student Alisa Sheremeta (9.825), Celestine (9.775) and freshman Addison Lawrence (9.300) additionally partook in the event. The Tigers finished their second rotation with a 98.525.

In the beam rotation, Hu led the Tigers once again with a 9.950 finish. Davis finished slightly behind her with a 9.825, followed by Sheremeta and Schreiber each scoring 9.700. McCrary (9.500) and Lawrence (9.150) also led off the rotation. Missouri scored 48.675 as a unit to enter the final rotation with a score of 147.200.

Mizzou rounded out the meet on floor with Schreiber tallying a 9.875 in the leadoff spot. Both Sheremeta and Celestine topped the Tiger scoreboard with 9.925 finishes.
