### WEEKLY HONORS

• **SEC Gymnast of the Week** – Kentucky's Raena Worley, a fifth-year from Christiansburg, Va., won her 26th career all-around title with a score of 39.750 in the win over No. 28 BYU. Worley recorded her first perfect 10.0 on bars for her 13th win on the event. She also posted her 22nd career win on floor with a score of 9.975 in the anchor spot to help the Wildcats register their second-highest team score in the event (49.675). Worley concluded the meet with a second-place finish on vault with a 9.90 and tied for fourth place on beam with a 9.875.

• **SEC Co-Specialist of the Week** – LSU's Aleah Finnegan, a junior from Lee's Summit, Mo., recorded a perfect 10.0 on floor in the win over No. 12 Auburn for her five career perfect mark and her third on the event. Finnegan also took the event title on vault with a score of 9.95 and tied for fourth place on the balance beam with a score of 9.925. She has now tallied 18 individual titles in her collegiate career, including six on floor and two on vault.

Missouri's Mara Titarsolej, a senior from Zutphen, Netherlands, made history at the Mizzou to the Lou event after posting Missouri's first perfect 10 on bars in program history. Titarsolej reset her own program record on the event, and she now holds the program's top three bar scores after just seven meets as a Tiger. With her performance, Missouri set a program record team score on bars with a 49.500, besting the four-team field on the apparatus.

• **SEC Freshman of the Week** – Florida's Anya Pilgrim, a freshman from Germantown, Md., earned a share of third place in the all-around at the Mizzou to the Lou quad meet with her score of 39.525. In her fifth outing this season in the all-around, Pilgrim posted scores of 9.90 on the uneven bars, the balance beam and floor exercise. She also recorded a 9.825 on vault to help the Gators finish first against No. 14 Missouri, No. 27 Illinois and Lindenwood.

Arkansas took second place with a score of 197.375, followed by Arizona (196.950) and host Texas Woman's (195.725).

In the all-around, Gabby Gladieux claimed the top spot with her score of 39.525. Teammate Luisa Blanco finished second with a score of 39.450.

Makarri Doggette captured the vault title with her score of 9.90, and Cameron Machado earned the bars title with her score of 9.975. Lilly Hudson earned a share of the floor title with a score of 9.95.

In the team's first of two meets on the weekend, No. 16 Arkansas faced a stack field and bounced back after a tough second rotation to come in third of four teams at the Metroplex Challenge with a score of 196.800.

Lauren Williams scored a 9.925 on vault to earn a share of the event title, and Frankie Price scored 9.950 on floor to come in a five-way tie for first. It was the third title on the season for each on their respective events.

The Gymbacks started the night on bars and scored 49.400, which matches their season high. They then hit a setback with a 48.650 on beam, but bounced back well and didn't score lower than 49.300 on either of the remaining two events with a 49.450 on floor and 49.300 on vault.

Arkansas went to to take second place at the TWU Quad Meet with a final score of 197.375. No. 10 Alabama finished first with a season-high score of 197.625, while Arizona (196.950) and Texas Woman's (195.725) placed third and fourth, respectively.

Hailey Klein won the event title on beam with her top score of 9.925.

Arkansas returns home to host No. 6 Kentucky on Friday, February 23 for a 7:30 p.m. CT meet, live on SEC Network.

The No. 12 Auburn gymnastics team finished with a 197.100 on the road, earning a season-best road score as No.3 LSU won the meet with a 198.300 on February 16 in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center.

Fifth year Cassie Stevens finished second in the all-around with a 49.475, while senior Olivia Hollingsworth earned a 49.375 and junior Sophia Groth finished with a 49.350.

Auburn kicked off the meet with a 49.100 on bars with Stevens and senior Gabby McLaughlin leading the charge. The pair each earned 9.85s for the squad. Fifth year Aria Brusch, Groth and redshirt freshman Olivia Greaves each added a 9.8 to the overall team score.

The Tigers put together a 49.250 in the second rotation on vault. Freshman Julianne Huff finished second in the event, tying her career high with a 9.925. Stevens anchored the rotation with a 9.9, earning a 9.9 or better in four-straight meets.

Seniors Sydney Schumaker and Olivia Hollingsworth added 9.825s to the overall vault score with junior Sara Hubbard chipping in a 9.775.

Auburn continued to build in the third rotation, going 49.300 on floor. Hollingsworth anchored with another 9.9, her fifth 9.9 or better this season. Brusch led off the event with a 9.875 and Groth chipped in a 9.875 as well. Stevens earned a 9.85 and McLaughlin added a 9.8 for the Tigers.

The squad concluded the night on beam, scoring 49.450. Groth and McLaughlin led the way with a pair of 9.925s. That score was a season best for Groth. Stevens and Hollingsworth each earned a 9.875, while Brusch finished with a 9.85.

Auburn returns to the Plains for one last meet in Neville Arena in 2024. The Tigers will host nationally-ranked Missouri on February 23 at 6 p.m. CT and the meet will be televised on SEC Network.

A season-best 197.925 elevated No. 6 Florida to win the Mizzou at the Lou quad meet held in front of 5,995 who braved the snow to be at the Family Arena on February 16. No. 14 Missouri was second at 197.475, followed by No. 27 Illinois (196.55) and Lindenwood (194.825).

Uneven bars opened competition for Florida. For the second consecutive week, freshman Gabby Disidore raised her collegiate best, this time to 9.925 to lead the Gators. Anya Pilgrim and Leanne Wong also posted 9.90 to start the meet.

Freshman Skylar Draser led off the Gators' balance beam lineup with a collegiate-best 9.90. Two other Gators – Pilgrim and Ellie Lazzari - earned 9.9 beam marks. Wong anchored with a near-perfect 9.975 to up Florida's beam total to a season-high 49.55.


All marks used toward Florida's season-best 49.60 floor exercise total were 9.90 or better. Victoria Nguyen led off the lineup with a 9.90 and Pilgrim also earned the same score. It was season bests for the bottom half of UF's lineup as Sloane Blakely and Payton Richards turned in marks of 9.925. Wong anchored with a 9.95.

Blakely led the Gators on their final event, winning vault with a season-best 9.925. Danie Ferris and Wong closed the lineup with a pair of 9.90s.

Florida swept the all-around, with Wong winning her third title of 2024 after matching her season-high of 39.725 for the second consecutive week. Blakely posted a season-high 39.55 for second and Pilgrim closed the sweep at 39.525.

Up next, Florida will host LSU on Friday, February 23 at 6:45 p.m. in the Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center, live on ESPN2.

The No. 19 Georgia gymnastics team finished with its second-highest score of the season in its loss to No. 3 LSU, 197.625-197.075, before 9,811 spectators on February 9 inside Stegeman Coliseum.

The GymDogs finished with a season-high on floor, a 49.475, with three athletes totaling a 9.900 or better in the event. In her third meet competing all-around, freshman Lily Smith totaled a 39.525.

The GymDogs posted a 49.050 on vault. Both Jaydah Battle and JaFree Scott finished with season best scores, totaling a 9.800 and 9.825 respectively. Ady Wahl anchored the rotation and earned a team-best 9.850.


Georgia had all five of its counted scores finish with a 9.800 or better on bars. In her second time competing in the event this season, Naya Howard earned a 9.850 from the lead off spot. Both Holly Snyder and Smith's performances gave them a 9.875. The Bulldogs finished with a 49.250 for the second time this year.

The Bulldogs posted a 49.300 on beam, marking just the fifth time the program has at least reached the score in the last 19 meets dating back to the start of last season. Three GymDogs totaled a 9.875 – Battle, Smith and Scott.

To cap off the night, four gymnasts finished on floor with season-best performances. Performing third in the rotation, Ashlyn LaClair had a 9.875, followed by Cashman and Wahl's scores of a 9.900 and capped off by Smith's 9.95. The GymDogs ended the evening with their highest score in the event, a 49.475, since posting a 49.500 against Alabama on Feb. 17, 2023.

Following a bye, Georgia will return to action on Friday, February 23 at 8 p.m. to take on Alabama in Tuscaloosa.

No. 5 Kentucky gymnastics defeated No. 28 BYU, 197.775-196.600, on February 16 in Rupp Arena at Central Bank Center.

Fifth-year senior Raena Worley earned her first career 10.000 on the uneven bars following two perfect scores this season on the floor exercise. In addition to her exciting mark, Worley also earned her 26th all-around title and 22nd individual win on floor.

Kentucky kicked off the night on vault. Sixth-year senior Arianna Patterson was the top score of the night, earning a big 9.925 for a stunning front entry front pike half completed with a stuck landing. Tallying the mark for the third time this season, Patterson earned her sixth career individual win on the apparatus. Worley was UK's second-highest score on vault earning a 9.900, while Isabella Magnelli finished third with a 9.875.

Concluding the meet on the floor exercise, the Wildcats scored a cumulative 49.675 setting a second-best mark on the event. Earning the top mark of the night on floor was Worley with a near-perfect 9.975. Creslyn Brose, who has been a standout on the event all season, earned a 9.950 for her energetic routine. Both Makenzie Wilson and Magnelli executed near-perfect performances, each earning 9.925 with Davis earning her fifth 9.900 of her senior season.

Kentucky will return to the road next week as the program travels to Fayetteville for an 8:30 p.m. ET meet against Arkansas, live on SEC Network.

The No. 3 LSU Gymnastics team defeated No. 12 Auburn in front of a sold-out crowd by a score of 198.300-197.100 on February 16 in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center.

The victory marked LSU's eighth straight win over the visiting Tigers when facing off in the PMAC. The score was also the squad's third 198 of the year, making LSU the team with the second-most scores on that scale so far this year. It was the Tigers' fifth conference win and seventh overall against a ranked opponent this year.

Five LSU Tigers had season high performances against Auburn. Aleah Finnegan recorded season highs on vault (9.95), floor (10.0) and beam (9.925), while Kiya Johnson's beam routine was also a season high (9.95). Ashley Cowan matched her career high on bars (9.90) and Alexis Jeffrey set a career high on beam (9.925).

Finnegan finished the meet as the top performer on vault and floor. She now owns 18 titles in her career and added to her individual event titles with six on floor and two on vault.

Haleigh Bryant earned a share of the bars title with teammate Savannah Schoenherr as well her third straight all-around title and fifth this year. She finished the night with a score of 39.700. The senior now owns 75 career individual titles and moved her total to 24 in the all-around and 11 on bars. Her two titles on the night put her ahead of Susan Jackson in the program records, as she now sits at sixth all-time.

It was Schoenherr's second title for the Purple & Gold and second on bars.

Konnor McClain's beam routine earned her the victory on the event (9.975), moving her total to four this year, with three of those coming on beam.

LSU will get ready to travel to Gainesville and face Florida on Friday, February 23 at 6 p.m. CT on ESPN2.

In front of 5,995 fans, the No. 14-ranked University of Missouri gymnastics team claimed second place, posting an overall team score of 197.475 on February 16 inside Family Arena in St. Charles, Mo. It is the team's best score of the season and marks the fifth time the Tigers have scored over 197 in 2024.

Senior Mara Titarsolej posted a record-breaking score in the anchor spot bars, stepping up to the plate in the anchor spot performed a flawless routine, securing the program's first perfect 10 on bars (second of her career) and to clinch an event win.

Titarsolej's program-best score lifted MU to its highest-ever team bars score of 49.500. She joined senior Kyra Burns, graduate student Sienna Schreiber and and junior Jocelyn Moore as the four Tigers to score 9.9 or higher.

On the floor, junior Amari Celestine clinched her second 9.950 in a row, positioning herself in a tie for first on the event with Florida's Leanne Wong.

No. 6 Florida won the meet with a 197.925, while Illinois finished third with a 196.550 and Lindenwood rounded out the group with a 194.825. The top three teams beat their averages by at least four-tenths of a point.

The Tigers compete in their final SEC road meet next weekend, traveling down to The Plains to face Auburn on Friday, February 23. First touch from Neville Arena is slated for 6 p.m. CT, and the contest will broadcast on Friday Night Heights on SEC Network.
