By now you are aware that we've spent this 2009 announcing a dues increase for the BASS Federation Nation. This past January and February we shared detailed financial information with the state presidents. We also understand the importance of communicating the reasons behind a dues increase well in advance and not at the end of the year.

We realize any type of dues increase is difficult, but dues have never been commensurate with the cost of running the BFN. This only marks the 3rd dues increase since the BFN's inception and that's a pretty good track record when all things are considered.

When you speak with your members it's important to note that these decisions are never easy and the amount wasn't decided upon until after we shared very open and lengthy discussions with the state leadership. We settled on the most reasonable increase after taking all feedback and the economy into consideration.

Once you combine the BASS benefits to your state benefits, we feel like together these membership benefits are second to none.
