- At least one SEC team has reached the College World Series finals for the 14th time in the last 15 tournaments. This marks the fifth time two SEC teams will play in the finals and the third time in the last six tournaments. An SEC team will win the College World Series for the 15th time overall.
- Florida and LSU will meet for the national championship for the second time. The two teams also played in the 2017 CWS finals with the Gators winning the series 2-0. This is the first time in five SEC vs. SEC matchups that the two teams did not meet in the regular season.
- An SEC team will win the national championship for the fourth consecutive tournament - all by four different programs. Vanderbilt won in 2019, Mississippi State in 2021 and Ole Miss in 2022.
- LSU is playing for the national championship for the eighth time. The Tigers lead all SEC programs with six national titles. Florida is playing in the CWS finals for the fourth time. The Gators won the crown in 2017.
- The SEC will now claim nine national titles by six different teams since 2009. Following this year's CWS finals, eight SEC teams will have finished runner-up in that period.
- The SEC led all conferences with three teams (Florida, LSU, Tennessee) in the 2023 College World Series. This is the sixth consecutive CWS in which the SEC has had more teams in the field than any other conference. Nine different SEC programs have made a trip to Omaha for the College World Series since 2021.

- This marked the first time that nine SEC teams won at least 16 conference games.
- A record-tying and nation-leading six SEC baseball teams advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals. Six SEC teams have advanced to the Super Regionals in five of the last seven tournaments.
- A record-tying and nation-leading 10 SEC baseball teams earned NCAA Tournament bids. This marked the fourth time that 10 SEC teams earned NCAA Tournament bids. Ten teams were also selected in 2014, 2018 and 2019.
- A record eight SEC programs were selected among 16 NCAA Regional hosts. The previous record was seven SEC hosts in 2016 and 2021.
- Winners of the individual SEC awards as voted on by the league's head coaches were: LSU's Dylan Crews (Player of the Year), LSU's Paul Skenes (Pitcher of the Year), Georgia's Charlie Condon (Freshman of the Year), Alabama's Andrew Pinckney and Georgia's Ben Anderson (Co-Scholar-Athletes of the Year), and Arkansas' Dave Van Horn (Coach of the Year).
- A total of 109 SEC baseball student-athletes were eligible to wear the SEC graduate patch on their uniforms, signifying that they have earned their college degrees.
- A total of 88 players formerly from SEC schools were named to MLB opening day rosters. No other conference had more than 52 players on opening day rosters.
- Total attendance for baseball games on SEC campuses this season was more than 2.99 million.
